16	Section 540. <u>A.</u> Any person who willfully delays or obstructs
17	any public officer in the discharge <u>of</u> or attempt to discharge any
18	duty of his or her office, is shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a
19	misdemeanor felony punishable by imprisonment in the custody of the
20	Department of Corrections for a term not exceeding two (2) years, or
21	by a fine of not less than Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars
22	(\$2,500.00), or by both such fine and imprisonment.
23	${f B.}$ Nothing in this section shall preclude a person from
24	recording the activity of law enforcement in a public area, as long
