| 15 | Section 1743. A. No person using an unmanned aircraft system  |
| 16 | (UAS) or drone, as defined by the Federal Aviation Administration,  |
| 17 | shall, except as authorized by law:   |
| 18 | 1. Trespass onto private property or into airspace within four  |
| 19 | hundred (400) feet above ground level with the intent to subject  |
| 20 | anyone to eavesdropping or other surveillance;  |
| 21 | 2. Install on private property, without the consent of the  |
| 22 | owner or lessee, any device for observing, photographing, recording,  |
| 23 | amplifying, or broadcasting sounds or events on such property, or   |

3. Intentionally use a drone to photograph, record, or
 otherwise observe another person in any place where the person has a
 reasonable expectation of privacy; or

4 4. Intentionally land a drone on the lands or waters that are
5 the private property of another without the consent of the owner or
6 lessee.

7 A person who violates this act is guilty of a misdemeanor. Β. Paragraph 3 of subsection A of this section shall not apply to a 8 9 drone operator operating a drone for a bona fide business or bona 10 fide government purpose who unintentionally or incidentally 11 photographs, records, or otherwise observes another person in a 12 private place, nor shall it apply to a designated emergency 13 management worker or government employee or contractor operating a 14 drone within the scope of his or her lawful duties of employment. 15 Paragraph 4 of subsection A of this section shall not apply to the 16 landing of a drone required in the interest of safety or otherwise 17 in an emergency such as to avoid collision with a person or 18 property.

19 <u>C. The only authorized government drone operators in the State</u> 20 <u>of Oklahoma to operate a drone in a residential area are public</u> 21 <u>safety agencies.</u>

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
