<u>AS INTRODUCED</u>
An Act relating to cemeteries; requiring human bodies be buried in a certain manner; authorizing governing
body of a political subdivision of this state to permit certain burials; providing applicability;
providing for codification; and providing an effective date.
BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 38 of Title 8, unless there is
created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
A. The body of a human decedent that is buried shall be buried
in a manner where the top surface of the outermost container in
which the body is placed is a minimum of eighteen (18) inches below
the surface of the ground. If the body of a human decedent is
buried without a container, the depth of the grave shall be a
minimum of forty-eight (48) inches below the surface of the ground.
B. Due to subsurface soil conditions or other relevant
considerations, the governing body of a political subdivision of

this state may permit, by ordinance or rule, burials in that political subdivision at a shallower depth than required by subsection A of this section. C. This section shall not apply to burials in sealed-surface reinforced concrete burial vaults or burials on tribal grounds. SECTION 2.
