- SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 14-134.1 of Title 70, unless
- 3 | there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
- A. Within the system of career technology districts, no fees shall be charged to:
- 1. Children of Oklahoma peace officers as defined by Section

 648 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes who have given their lives

- 9 2. Children of Oklahoma firefighters who have given their lives 10 in the line of duty;
- 3. Children of commissioned members of the Oklahoma Law

- B. Such waiver of **fees** shall be limited to a period of five (5) years.

- D. For purposes of this section:
- 1. "Firefighter" means a volunteer firefighter or a permanent salaried professional member of any fire department within the State of Oklahoma; and

2	or employed as an emergency medical technician and who is licensed
3	as an emergency medical technician pursuant to Section 1-2505 of

5	SECTION 4. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
