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15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2011, Section 5-135.4, as
17	last amended by Section 1, Chapter 282, O.S.L. 2018 (70 O.S. Supp.
18	2020, Section 5-135.4), is amended to read as follows:
19	Section 5-135.4 A. This section shall be known and may be
20	cited as the "School District Transparency Act".
21	B. The State Department of Education shall make <u>school district</u>
22	revenue sources and school district and school site expenditure data
23	available on its website. Data shall be made available in an open-
24	structured data format that may be downloaded by the public and that

allows the user to systematically sort, search, and access all data 1 without any fee or charge for access. Prior to the beginning of the 2 2019-2020 school year, if a school district has a website, the 3 4 district shall provide a link on its home page to the State 5 Department of Education's Oklahoma Cost Accounting System and School District Financial Information website, or the district shall 6 7 provide the information required by subsection C of this section within one click of the home page of the school district's website. 8 9 С. The website shall provide information on school district 10 revenue sources and school district and school site expenditures of 11 state, federal, and local funds, whether appropriated or 12 nonappropriated, excluding payments of voluntary payroll deductions 13 for employees to receiving parties. The website shall further 14 provide information, including, but not limited to, the following: 15 Identification of the school district: 1. 16 2. defined by the requirements of the OCAS including a listing of the
base salary, insurance, retirement and other fringe benefits
including exempted nonadministrative services such as teaching in
the classroom or serving as a principal, counselor or library media
specialist pursuant to subsection E of Section 18-124 of this title;

14 <u>10. A list of all revenue sources of the school district,</u>
 15 <u>organized by category including, but not limited to, the categories</u>
 16 <u>of local funds, county funds, state funds, federal funds and other</u>
 17 <u>revenue sources. The list shall include percentages for each</u>
 18 category to show the total revenue of the school district.

D. The Department shall make the data available on its website
within one hundred twenty (120) days of transmission of the
expenditures to the Department by the school district.

E. School districts shall provide information requested by theDepartment to accomplish the purposes of this section.

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F. If a school district maintains a website, the district shall
 provide the information required in subsection C of this section in
 the manner prescribed in subsection B of this section on the
 district website.

G. Nothing in this section shall require the disclosure of
information which is required to be kept confidential by state or
federal law.

8 H. The disclosure of information required by this section shall 9 create no liability whatsoever, civil or criminal, to the State of 10 Oklahoma, the State Department of Education, school districts, or 11 any employee thereof for disclosure of required information or for 12 any error or omission in the disclosure.

I. The Department shall undertake activities annually to inform parents, schools and other stakeholders about the availability of <u>school district revenue sources and</u> school district and school site expenditure data on its website and how to use the website.

17 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.

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
