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14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 464.2 of Title 74, unless there
17	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
18	A. Each member elected to the Legislature shall be required
19	within one (1) year after taking the oath of office to attend the
20	Institute for the Continuing Education of State Government
21	officials. The Institute shall be conducted in cooperation with the
22	Oklahoma Ethics Commission, by or under the supervision of a
23	bipartisan organization that is exempt from taxation under federal

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law and designated pursuant to the provisions of the Internal

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   Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C., Section 170(a). The organization shall
   demonstrate to the Oklahoma Ethics Commission that it has
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   represented state legislatures and has conducted training programs
   for state legislatures for at least fifteen (15) years prior to
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   January 1, 2020. It shall further demonstrate that its continuous
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   official purpose is to promote the general welfare of state
   government, to provide technical assistance and consultative
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   services and other aids for the improvement and increased efficiency
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   of state government.
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- B. The Institute shall consist of twenty (20) continuing education hours of instruction. A certificate of completion shall be awarded to members who attend and successfully complete the instruction and a list of those members shall be filed with the Oklahoma Ethics Commission.
- C. The curriculum for the Institute shall include, but not be limited to: state budget requirements, tax, ethics, procedures for conducting meetings, bill drafting and analysis procedures.
- D. A member of the Legislature who fails to satisfy the continuing education requirements of this section shall be ineligible to file for reelection.
- 21 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.

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
