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12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 68 O.S. 2021, Section 2940, is
14	amended to read as follows:
15	Section 2940. <u>A.</u> Whenever the United States, the state, or a
16	city, town, county, school district, or any other political
17	subdivision, including, but not limited to, a turnpike authority,
18	municipal trust, water or conservation district, flood control
19	district, levee or waterway improvement district, urban renewal
20	authority, public housing authority, or any other authority
21	authorized by law, state or federal, acquires title to any real
22	property for a governmental purpose between January 1 and October 1
23	of the tax year, such property shall be relieved of ad valorem tax
24	for the remaining months of the year beginning with the first of the

1 month next succeeding the date its acquisition for public purposes becomes a matter of public record, if the deed thereto was recorded 2 prior to October 1; provided, however, that all taxes assessed 3 4 against such property prior to its acquisition shall be paid in full 5 and there be paid a sum equal to one-twelfth (1/12) times the number of months that the property remained in private ownership of an 6 7 amount estimated by the county treasurer of the county wherein the real property lies to be substantially equal to the amount of tax 8 9 which would have been or will become due and payable for the year 10 had the real property not been acquired for public purposes. In 11 estimating the amount of taxes which would have been or will become 12 due and payable for the tax year had the real property not been acquired for public purposes the county treasurer shall use as a 13 14 basis the current assessment and the tax rate for the preceding 15 year, unless the tax for the current year shall be by then 16 determined and set, in which event he shall use as basis the new 17 assessment and rate. The public agency acquiring the property shall 18 deduct the amount of such taxes from the purchase price payable to 19 the private owner and remit the same to the county treasurer in 20 satisfaction of such taxes. The county treasurer of any county is 21 hereby authorized upon order of the board of tax roll corrections to 22 cancel of record all taxes assessed against such property for the 23 year of its acquisition when the deed thereto was recorded prior to 24 October 1 and the aforesaid estimated amount of the tax for the

1 months that the property was in private ownership is paid, which order shall be issued upon application of the acquiring authority. 2 B. If real property is sold to an entity that is exempt from 3 4 payment of ad valorem tax pursuant to federal law, Section 6 of 5 Article X of the Oklahoma Constitution or otherwise, notwithstanding the terms of sale or the provisions of any escrow agreement between 6 7 the seller and the buyer, if the seller of the property, or the seller's agent, makes a request of the county treasurer of the 8 9 applicable county to provide an ad valorem tax bill for the property 10 based on the tax liability as determined for the property as of the sale date, the county treasurer shall provide such statement to the 11 12 seller not later than ten (10) business days from the date of any 13 written request to do so.
