10                                   COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

11                   An Act relating to environment and natural resources;  
12                   amending 27A O.S. 2011, Section 2-6-107, which  
13                   relates to the definition of gray water; allowing the  
14                   use of wastewater from splash pads for certain  
15                   purposes and under certain conditions without a  
16                   permit; providing for references to certain terms;  
17                   and providing an effective date.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19                   SECTION 1.           AMENDATORY           27A O.S. 2011, Section 2-6-107, is  
20 amended to read as follows:

21                   Section 2-6-107.   A.   "Gray water" means untreated household  
22 wastewater that has not come in contact with toilet waste and  
23 includes wastewater from bathtubs, showers, washbasins, clothes  
24 washing machines and laundry tubs and untreated municipal wastewater

1 limited to wastewater captured from municipal splash pads and water  
2 used by fire departments for cleaning equipment and vehicles. Gray  
3 water shall not include wastewater from kitchen sinks, kitchen  
4 dishwashers or laundry water from the washing of material soiled  
5 with human excreta, such as diapers.

6 B. The definition of gray water in subsection A of this section  
7 shall apply only in municipalities enacting ordinances regulating  
8 the use of gray water within the limits of their municipal  
9 boundaries.

10 C. The Department of Environmental Quality shall not require a  
11 permit for reusing captured wastewater from a splash pad for  
12 irrigation or land application, with or without intermediary storage  
13 units, if the splash pad is within the jurisdictional boundaries of  
14 a municipality that has enacted an ordinance regulating the  
15 management of wastewater from splash pads and the ordinance, at a  
16 minimum, includes the same conditions and restrictions as set forth  
17 in paragraphs 5, 8, 11 and 12 of subsection A of Section 2-6-108 of  
18 this title. For purposes of this subsection, the term "splash pad"  
19 shall also include facilities known as spray pools, spray pads and  
20 spray grounds.

21 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
