19	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 27A O.S. 2011, Section 2-6-107, is
20	amended to read as follows:
21	Section 2-6-107. A. "Gray water" means untreated household
22	wastewater that has not come in contact with toilet waste and
23	includes wastewater from bathtubs, showers, washbasins, clothes
24	washing machines and laundry tubs and untreated municipal wastewater

BOLD FACE CAPITALIZED language denotes Committee Amendments. Gray 3 water shall not include wastewater from kitchen sinks, kitchen 4 dishwashers or laundry water from the washing of material soiled 5 with human excreta, such as diapers.

B. The definition of gray water in subsection A of this section
shall apply only in municipalities enacting ordinances regulating
the use of gray water within the limits of their municipal
boundaries.

10 C. The Department of Environmental Quality shall not require a 11 permit for reusing captured wastewater from a splash pad for 12 irrigation or land application, with or without intermediary storage 13 units, if the splash pad is within the jurisdictional boundaries of 14 a municipality that has enacted an ordinance regulating the 15 management of wastewater from splash pads and the ordinance, at a 16 minimum, includes the same conditions and restrictions as set forth in paragraphs 5, 8, 11 and 12 of subsection A of Section 2-6-108 of 17 18 this title. For purposes of this subsection, the term "splash pad" 19 shall also include facilities known as spray pools, spray pads and 20 spray grounds. 21 SECTION 2.
