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L 4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5028 of Title 63, unless there
L7	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
18	A. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall be authorized and
L9	directed to submit a waiver to the Center for Medicaid and Medicare
20	Services. The waiver will be for uncompensated care provided in
21	Indian Health Service health facilities, Native American tribal
22	health facilities and Urban Indian Organization health facilities.
23	The waiver will provide payments to these facilities for formerly

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reimbursable services, and more generally to cover otherwise uncompensated care.

- B. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority may take such actions, including but not limited to any waivers authorized by federal law, in order to perform obligations pursuant to agreements entered into pursuant to subsection A of this section.
- C. To the extent required by the provisions of federal law, tribal law or other provisions of law affecting a federally recognized Native American tribe, the provisions of this section and the actions taken by the Oklahoma Health Care Authority authorized by this section shall be deemed and shall constitute the consent of the State of Oklahoma to agreements executed by the Oklahoma Health Care Authority.
- SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5029 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

If the Oklahoma Health Care Authority is unable to obtain federal financial participation and waiver approval from the Center for Medicaid and Medicare Services, this act shall be null and void.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

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declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
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    be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
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
