| BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA: |
| SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be |
| codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows: |
| A. Effective July 1, 2015, full-time employees specified in |
| subsection B of this section, including temporary and other limited |
| term employees of the state, who were employed by the state on the |
| last working day of June 2015 shall be awarded an annualized salary |
| increase equal to six and one-quarter percent (6.25%) of the |
| officer's or employee's annualized salary as of June 30, 2015. |

B. Employees of the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority shall be
 awarded a salary increase in accordance with the provisions of this
 section.

4 C. As used in this section, "temporary and other limited-term 5 employees" are those persons who:

6 1. Are not permanent employees;

7 2. Are not otherwise excluded by this section; and

3. Are compensated by the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority for a
9 limited duration and without any subjective expectation by either
10 the employer or the employee that the employment will become
11 permanent.

D. Employees eligible for the increase provided for in subsection A of this section who are on leave without pay on July 1, 2015, shall receive an annualized increase, effective upon their return to work, but shall not receive any increase for a period of time prior to their return to work.

17 Employees who leave the state service before July 1, 2015, Ε. 18 and who are reinstated or reemployed in the state service during 19 July 2015 without a break in service, who are otherwise eligible for 20 the pay increase provided for in this section, shall be granted such 21 raise effective immediately upon such reinstatement or reemployment. 22 As used in this subsection, "break in service" is defined as a 23 period of time in excess of thirty (30) calendar days between two 24 periods of state employment.
