8	provide employees caring for servicemember paid leave; defining terms; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.
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11	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
12	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 901 of Title 40, unless there is
14	created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
15	A. Public and private employers shall provide any employee who
16	is the spouse, son, daughter, parent, or next of kin of a covered
17	servicemember, a total of twenty-six (26) workweeks of paid leave
18	during a twelve (12) month period to care for the servicemember.
19	B. As used in this section:
20	1. "Covered servicemember" means:
21	a. a member of the Armed Forces who is undergoing medical
22	treatment, recuperation, or therapy, is otherwise in
23	outpatient status, or is otherwise on the temporary

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disability retired list, for a serious injury or illness; or

- b. a veteran who is undergoing medical treatment, recuperation, or therapy, for a serious injury or illness and who was a member of the Armed Forces at any time during the period of five (5) years preceding the date on which the veteran undergoes that medical treatment, recuperation, or therapy.
- 2. "Employee" means any person who supplies labor for remuneration to his or her employer in this state and shall not include an independent contractor, subcontractor or employees of an independent contractor;
- 3. "Employer" means any person, firm, corporation, partnership, association or nonprofit organization, which has one or more employees within this state, or which has offered or may offer employment to one or more individuals in this state;
- 4. "Next of kin" means the nearest blood relative of that individual;
- 5. "Outpatient status", with respect to a covered servicemember, means the status of a member of the Armed Forces assigned to:
 - a. a military medical treatment facility as an outpatient; or

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- b. a unit established for the purpose of providing command and control of members of the Armed Forces receiving medical care as outpatients.
- 6. "Public employer" means the State of Oklahoma or any political subdivision thereof, including any department, agency, board, commission, institution, authority, public trust, municipality, county, district or instrumentalities thereof;
 - 7. "Serious injury or illness" means:

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- a. in the case of a member of the Armed Forces, means an injury or illness that was incurred by the member in line of duty on active duty in the Armed Forces or existed before the beginning of the member's active duty and was aggravated by service in line of duty on active duty in the Armed Forces and that may render the member medically unfit to perform the duties of the member's office, grade, rank, or rating; and
- b. in the case of a veteran who was a member of the Armed Forces at any time during a period described in subparagraph b of paragraph 1 of subsection B of this section means a injury or illness that was incurred by the member in line of duty on active duty in the Armed Forces or existed before the beginning of the member's active duty and was aggravated by service in line of duty on active duty in the Armed Forces and that

3	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
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
