An Act relating to public health; amending 63 O.S. 2011, Section 1-731, which relates to persons who may perform abortions; requiring that certain physicians specialize in certain fields; and providing an effective date.

SUBJECT: Public health

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2011, Section 1-731, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1-731. A. No person shall perform or induce an abortion upon a pregnant woman unless that person is a physician licensed to practice medicine in the State of Oklahoma who is board-certified in obstetrics and gynecology. Any person violating this section shall be guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment for not less than one (1) year nor more than three (3) years in the State Penitentiary custody of the Department of Corrections.

B. No person shall perform or induce an abortion upon a pregnant woman subsequent to the end of the first trimester of her

pregnancy, unless such abortion is performed or induced in a general hospital.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
