6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to environment and natural resources;
8 amending 27A O.S. 2011, Section 2-7-120, which
9 relates to the fee for disposal of liquid waste;
10 clarifying type of underground injection well used
11 for disposal; updating statutory language;
12 establishing total annual fee for disposal of
13 drinking water treatment residuals in certain
14 injection wells; and declaring an emergency.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 27A O.S. 2011, Section 2-7-120, is
17 amended to read as follows:

18 Section 2-7-120. Any person subject to regulation by the
19 Department of Environmental Quality disposing of liquid waste other
20 than hazardous waste in an underground injection well that is
21 required to be permitted shall pay a fee of two-hundredths of one
22 cent (0.002) per gallon for such disposal, provided that the total
23 fee shall be not less than Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) nor
24 more than Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) per year, except as
otherwise provided. The total fee for injection of drinking water
treatment residuals into a Class V underground injection well shall

1 be not less than Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) nor more than Five
2 Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) per year. Said fee shall be paid to
3 the Department on a quarterly basis within one (1) month following
4 the close of each quarter for the waste disposed in that preceding
5 quarter. Said fees shall be deposited into the Department of
6 Environmental Quality Revolving Fund.

7 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
8 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
9 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
10 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
