14	Management to Oklahoma Department of Emergency Management and Homeland Security; establishing a
15	revolving fund within the State Treasury; specifying purpose of fund; permitting the use of funds for
16	hazard mitigation planning and projects; and providing an effective date.

19	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
20	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 82 O.S. 2021, Section 1085.91, is
21	amended to read as follows:
22	Section 1085.91 In addition to the financial assistance program
23	programs established under Sections 1085.31 through 1085.49, 1085.51
24	through 1085.65, and 1085.71 through 1085.84A of Title 82 of the

Oklahoma Statutes this title pursuant to Section 39 of Article X of the Oklahoma Constitution, it is the intention of the Legislature to establish a Flood Hazard Mitigation Financial Assistance Program. Financing projects to mitigate flooding is certain hazards are hereby declared to be a public purpose.

6 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 82 O.S. 2021, Section 1085.92, is 7 amended to read as follows:

8 Section 1085.92 As used in the Flood Hazard Mitigation
9 Financial Assistance Program:

1. "Flood hazard <u>Hazard</u> mitigation projects" means those
 projects designed to correct, alleviate or eliminate a condition or
 situation which poses a repetitive threat to life, property, or
 public safety from the effects of a flood disaster;

14 2. "Eligible entity" means any city, town, county, or the State 15 of Oklahoma, and any rural water or sewer district, irrigation 16 district, public trust, master conservancy district, or other 17 political subdivision or any combination thereof;

18 3. "Board" means the Oklahoma Water Resources Board; and
19 4. "Department" means the Oklahoma Department of Civil
20 Emergency Management and Homeland Security.

21 SECTION 3. AMENDATORY 82 O.S. 2021, Section 1085.93, is 22 amended to read as follows:

Section 1085.93 A. In addition to other lawful purposes,
 monies placed in the Statewide Water Development Revolving Fund,

6	B. Within the Water Resources Fund created pursuant to Section
7	1085.33 of Title 82 of the Oklahoma Statutes, there is hereby
8	created the "Flood Hazard Mitigation Account". The account shall be
9	set apart as a permanent and perpetual account not subject to fiscal
10	year limitations and shall consist of:
11	1. All monies appropriated to the account;
12	2. Interest income from deposits made to the Statewide Water
13	Development Revolving Fund for the purpose of flood hazard
14	mitigation;
15	3. All income from the investment of monies held in the account
16	consistent with applicable bond resolutions or indentures; and
17	4. Any other sums designated for deposit to the account from
18	any source, public or private.
19	C. The monies in the account shall be used by the Oklahoma
20	Department of Civil Emergency Management and the Oklahoma Water
21	Resources Board after receipt of recommendations from the State
22	Hazard Mitigation Team, to implement flood hazard mitigation
23	projects, including but not limited to providing grants or loans to
24	eligible entities to:

1	1. Acquire land or a conservation easement from a willing
2	seller or grantor in order to mitigate flood hazards; or
3	2. Implement voluntary, incentive-based flood hazard mitigation
4	measures in order to facilitate compliance with state or national
5	regulations.
6	There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund
7	for the Oklahoma Water Resources Board to be designated the "Hazard
8	Mitigation Financial Assistance Fund". The fund shall be a
9	continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall
10	consist of all monies received by the Oklahoma Water Resources Board
11	from appropriations, dedicated revenues, fees or other sources as
12	provided by law. All monies accruing to the credit of said fund are
13	hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Oklahoma
14	Water Resources Board for the purpose of providing loans and grants
15	for hazard mitigation. Expenditures from said fund shall be made
16	upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as
17	prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and
18	Enterprise Services for approval and payment.
19	B. In addition to other lawful purposes, monies placed in the
20	Fund, exclusive of such amounts of interest derived from investment
21	deposits necessary to maintain the grant account, may be used by the
22	Board to implement hazard mitigation planning and projects,
23	including but not limited to, providing grants or loans to eligible
24	entities to:

1 <u>1. Develop a federal/state approved local/regional hazard</u> 2 mitigation planning document;

3 2. Acquire land or a conservation easement from a willing
 4 seller or grantor in order to mitigate hazards; or
 5 3. Implement voluntary, incentive-based hazard mitigation
 6 measures in order to facilitate compliance with state or national

7 regulations.

8 D. C. Monies in, or investment income derived from, the Flood 9 Hazard Mitigation Account Financial Assistance Fund which is used to 10 match any grant funds provided by the Federal Emergency Management 11 Agency or any other federal agencies shall be restricted and used 12 consistent with Federal Emergency Management Agency federal agencies 13 procedures or guidance or regulations promulgated thereunder for 14 flood hazard mitigation projects.

15 E. D. Monies in the Flood Hazard Mitigation Account Financial 16 Assistance Fund, or investment income derived therefrom, shall be 17 used by the Oklahoma Water Resources Board and the Oklahoma 18 Department of Civil Emergency Management and Homeland Security in 19 carrying out their responsibilities as provided in a written annual 20 joint operating agreement which shall include, among other matters, 21 a budget for administering the Oklahoma Flood Hazard Mitigation 22 Program.

F. E. The monies placed in the Flood Hazard Mitigation Account
 Financial Assistance Fund may be invested by the State Treasurer in

1 an adequately collateralized manner and as prescribed by Section 2 89.2 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes or pursuant to investment contracts or agreements with entities maintaining a rating in the 3 4 top two categories by a nationally recognized municipal bond rating 5 agency, all in a manner consistent with the federal Safe Drinking 6 Water Act or regulations promulgated thereunder regulations. The 7 Board may transfer to the Flood Hazard Mitigation Account Financial Assistance Fund income derived from investment of the fund. 8 Monies 9 invested by the State Treasurer shall be available to implement 10 flood hazard mitigation projects.

11 G. F. The Board shall cause to be completed an annual audit of 12 any expenditures from the Flood Hazard Mitigation Account Financial 13 Assistance Fund, and such audit cost shall be included in the budget 14 for administering the Oklahoma Flood Hazard Mitigation Program.

15 SECTION 4. AMENDATORY 82 O.S. 2021, Section 1085.94, is
16 amended to read as follows:

Section 1085.94 A. In addition to other powers and duties provided by law, the Oklahoma Water Resources Board shall have the power and duty to:

After receipt from the <u>Oklahoma</u> Department of Civil
 Emergency Management <u>and Homeland Security</u>, process applications for
 grant funds or loans from the Flood Hazard Mitigation Account
 <u>Financial Assistance Fund</u> and enter into grant or loan agreements
 for use of such funds;

2. Promulgate rules as deemed necessary by the Board to
 administer the Flood Hazard Mitigation Financial Assistance Program;
 3. Utilize the priority listing of applicants compiled by the
 Oklahoma Department of Civil Emergency Management and Homeland
 <u>Security</u> after recommendations from the State Hazard Mitigation Team
 in considering grant applications;

Issue investment certificates, in accordance with the a. provisions of Sections 1085.33 and 1085.37 of Title 82 8 9 of the Oklahoma Statutes this title and the Oklahoma 10 Bond Oversight and Reform Act, to provide necessary 11 funds first to meet the demand for loan funding from 12 the Flood Hazard Mitigation Financial Assistance Program; provided, any investment certificate proceeds 13 14 not needed for such demand may be used by the Board, 15 as needed, for funding other financial assistance 16 programs authorized in Title 82 of the Oklahoma 17 Statutes this title, and 18 b. Enter into loan agreements with and make loans from 19 the proceeds of investment certificates to eligible 20
- 20 entities for flood hazard mitigation projects upon 21 terms not inconsistent with the provisions of Section 22 1085.36 of Title 82 of the Oklahoma Statutes <u>this</u> 23 <u>title</u>; and

5. Enter into agreements with the Oklahoma Department of Civil
 Emergency Management <u>and Homeland Security</u> or other state or federal
 agencies as deemed necessary by the Board to monitor and measure
 flood hazard events.

B. In addition to other powers and duties provided by law, the
Oklahoma Department of Civil Emergency Management and Homeland
<u>Security</u> shall consider the recommendations, if any, of the State
Hazard Mitigation Team prior to:

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a. promulgation of

 listing of grant and loan applicants for flood hazard mitigation
 projects subject to the Oklahoma Civil Defense and Emergency
 Resources Management Act_T; and

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b. determining

15 <u>2. Determine</u> eligibility of those entities authorized to 16 receive funding from the Flood Hazard Mitigation Account <u>Financial</u> 17 Assistance Fund.

18 SECTION 5. AMENDATORY 82 O.S. 2021, Section 1085.95, is 19 amended to read as follows:

20 Section 1085.95 A. Loans and grants under the Flood Hazard 21 Mitigation Financial Assistance Program may be used in conjunction 22 with other financial assistance available from the Oklahoma Water 23 Resources Board.

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1	B. If a flood hazard mitigation project includes activities to
2	be conducted on privately owned real property, the loan or grant
3	agreement between the Board and the eligible entity that receives
4	the grant shall contain a provision about any necessary
5	subagreements with the owners of the property.
