9	schedule with salary range; allowing certain basic salary increases upon majority vote; eliminating							
10	certain salary reduction prohibition; modifying date on which changes in certain salaries and rates of pay take effect; replacing certain salary schedule with salary range; allowing certain basic salary increases upon majority vote; eliminating certain salary reduction prohibition; modifying date on which

13	changes in certain salaries and rates of pay take effect; repealing 19 O.S. 2011, Sections 180.63e and							
14	180.77, which relate to prohibition of certain salary modification during term of office; and providing an

18	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:							
19	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 2011, Section 180.62, is							
20	amended to read as follows:							
21	Section 180.62 A. The basic salaries of county officers upon							
22	which all salaries and future increases or decreases thereof shall							
23	be computed, shall <del>be as follows:</del>

1	1. In every county having a net valuation of all tangible						
2	taxable property, as defined in Sections 180.58 and 180.59 of this						
3	title, of Forty Million Dollars (\$40,000,000.00) or less, the basic						
4	salary of each of the county officers named in paragraph 1 of						
5	Section 180.61 of this title shall not be less than Nineteen						
6	Thousand Dollars (\$19,000.00) per annum nor shall it exceed Thirty-						
7	nine Thousand Dollars (\$39,000.00) per annum;						
8	2. In every county having a net valuation of all tangible						
9	taxable property, as defined in Sections 180.58 and 180.59 of this						
10	title, of more than Forty Million Dollars (\$40,000,000.00) but not						
11	more than Eighty Million Dollars (\$80,000,000.00), the basic salary						
12	of each of the county officers named in paragraph 1 of Section						
13	180.61 of this title shall not be less than Twenty-two Thousand Five						
14	Hundred Dollars (\$22,500.00) per annum nor shall it exceed Forty-two						
15	Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$42,500.00) per annum;						
16	3. In every county having a net valuation of all tangible						
17	taxable property, as defined in Sections 180.58 and 180.59 of this						
18	title, of more than Eighty Million Dollars (\$80,000,000.00) but not						
19	more than Three Hundred Million Dollars (\$300,000,000.00), the basic						
20	salary of each of the county officers named in paragraph 1 of						
21	Section 180.61 of this title shall not be less than Twenty-four						
22	Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$24,500.00) per annum nor shall it						
23	exceed Forty-four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$44,500.00) per						
24	annum;						

1	4. In every county having a net valuation of all tangible							
2	taxable property, as defined in Sections 180.58 and 180.59 of this							
3	title, of more than Three Hundred Million Dollars (\$300,000,000.00)							
4	but not more than Six Hundred Million Dollars (\$600,000,000.00), the							
5	basic salary of each of the county officers named in paragraph 1 of							
6	Section 180.61 of this title shall not be less than Twenty-two							
7	Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$22,500.00) per annum nor shall it							
8	exceed Forty-two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$42,500.00) per							
9	annum; and							
10	5. In every county having a net valuation of all tangible							
11	taxable property, as defined in Sections 180.58 and 180.59 of this							
12	title, of more than Six Hundred Million Dollars (\$600,000,000.00),							
13	the basic salary of each of the county officers named in paragraph 1							
14	of Section 180.61 of this title shall not be less than Nineteen							
15	Thousand Dollars (\$19,000.00) per annum nor shall it exceed Thirty-							
16	nine Thousand Dollars (\$39,000.00) per annum not be less than							
17	Nineteen Thousand Dollars (\$19,000.00) per annum nor shall they							
18	exceed Forty-four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$44,500.00).							
19	B. The board of county commissioners shall set the <u>basic</u>							
20	salaries for all elected county officials within the limits allowed							
21	by law.							
22	C. The annual salaries fixed by this act shall be paid either							
23	monthly or twice a month, by order of the board of county

commissioners, for each month or fraction thereof the incumbent
 lawfully occupies and holds title to such office.

3 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 2011, Section 180.63, is 4 amended to read as follows:

5 Section 180.63 In every county in this state, the salary of all county officers named in paragraph 1 of Section 180.61 of this title 6 7 may be increased from the applicable basic salary named in Section 180.62 of this title, for net valuation or serviceability service-8 9 ability; provided that by majority vote, the county commissioners, 10 at a public meeting, agree there are sufficient revenues in the 11 current budget to accept the increases provided in this section, 12 according to the following scale:

13 A. To the basic salary:

14 1. Add the product of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) times each 15 One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) net valuation, or major fraction 16 thereof until a net valuation of Seventy-five Million Dollars 17 (\$75,000,000.00) is reached;

18 2. Thereafter add the product of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) 19 times each additional Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000.00) net 20 valuation, or major fraction thereof until a net valuation of Five 21 Hundred Million Dollars (\$500,000,000.00) is reached;

3. Thereafter add the product of One Hundred Twenty-five
Dollars (\$125.00) times each additional Seven Million Dollars

1 (\$7,000,000.00) net valuation, or major fraction thereof until a net 2 valuation of Two Billion Dollars (\$2,000,000,000.00) is reached; and

4. Thereafter as to all additional net valuation add the
product of One Hundred Twenty-five Dollars (\$125.00) times each
additional Twenty Million Dollars (\$20,000,000.00) net valuation, or
major fraction thereof.

B. Also, the salary of each county officer shall be
additionally increased from the basic salary named in Section 180.62
of this title, and the additions thereto heretofore provided in this
section, for population or service load according to the following
scale:

12 1. The product of Twelve Dollars and fifty cents (\$12.50) times 13 each one thousand (1,000) population, or major fraction thereof 14 until a population of seventy-five thousand (75,000) is reached; 15 thereafter

16 2. The product of Twelve Dollars and fifty cents (\$12.50) times 17 each additional five thousand (5,000) population, or major fraction 18 thereof until a population of one hundred fifty thousand (150,000) 19 is reached; thereafter add

3. The product of Twelve Dollars and fifty cents (\$12.50) times each additional ten thousand (10,000) population, or major fraction thereof.

C. This section shall not reduce the present salary of any
 county officer in Oklahoma during their present term of office.

1SECTION 3.AMENDATORY19 O.S. 2011, Section 180.68, is2amended to read as follows:

3 Section 180.68 The date on which changes in the salaries and rates of pay for county officers and their deputies, aides and 4 5 assistants under this act due to changes in population or valuation in any county shall take effect, shall be as of, on and after the 6 7 first day of July of each fiscal year January based upon the population as shown by the latest Federal Decennial Census for the 8 9 State of Oklahoma, and the total net assessed valuations of tangible 10 properties for such year as shown by the official certificate which 11 the county assessor files with the county excise board for the 12 purpose of computing appropriations and levies for such current 13 fiscal year.

14SECTION 4.AMENDATORY19 O.S. 2011, Section 180.74, is15amended to read as follows:

Section 180.74 A. The basic salaries of county officers <u>listed</u> in paragraph 1 of Section 180.73 of this title upon which all salaries and future increases or decreases thereof shall be computed, shall be as follows:

20 1. In every county having a service-ability factor, as defined 21 in Section 180.71 of this title, of Four Hundred Thousand Dollars 22 (\$400,000.00) or less, the basic salary of each of the county 23 officers named in Section 180.73 of this title shall not be less

2	exceed Thirty-nine Thousand Dollars (\$39,000.00) per annum;						
3	2. In every county having a service-ability factor, as defined

5	Dollars (\$400,000.00) but not more than Eight Hundred Thousand						
6	Dollars (\$800,000.00), the basic salary of each of the county						
7	officers named in Section 180.73 of this title shall not be less						
8	than Twenty-two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$22,500.00) per annum						
9	nor shall it exceed Forty-two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars						
10	(\$42,500.00) per annum;						
11	3. In every county having a service-ability factor, as defined						
12	in Section 180.71 of this title, of more than Eight Hundred Thousand						
13	Dollars (\$800,000.00) but not more than Three Million Dollars						
14	(\$3,000,000.00), the basic salary of each of the county officers						
15	named in Section 180.73 of this title shall not be less than Twenty-						
16	four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$24,500.00) per annum nor shall						
17	it exceed Forty-four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$44,500.00) per						
18	annum;						
19	4. In every county having a service-ability factor, as defined						
20	in Section 180.71 of this title, of more than Three Million Dollars						
21	(\$3,000,000.00) but not more than Ten Million Dollars						
22	(\$10,000,000.00), the basic salary of each of the county officers						
23	named in Section 180.73 of this title shall not be less than Twenty-						
24	two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$22,500.00) per annum nor shall

1 it exceed Forty-two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$42,500.00) per
2 annum; and

3	5. In every county having a service-ability factor, as defined						
4	in Section 180.71 of this title, of more than Ten Million Dollars						
5	(\$10,000,000.00), the basic salary of each of the county officers						
6	named in Section 180.73 of this title shall not be less than						
7	Nineteen Thousand Dollars (\$19,000.00) per annum nor shall it exceed						
8	Thirty-nine Thousand Dollars (\$39,000.00) per annum not be less than						
9	Nineteen Thousand Dollars (\$19,000.00) per annum nor shall they						
10	exceed Forty-four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$44,500.00).						
11	B. The board of county commissioners shall set the <u>basic</u>						
12	salaries for all elected county officials within the limits allowed						
13	by law.						
14	C. The annual salaries fixed by Section 180.71 of this title						
15	shall be paid either monthly or twice a month, by order of the board						
16	of county commissioners, for each month or fraction thereof the						
17	incumbent lawfully occupies and holds title to such office.						
18	SECTION 5. AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 2011, Section 180.75, is						
19	amended to read as follows:						
20	Section 180.75 A. In every county in this state which approves						
21	an exemption of household goods of the heads of families and						
22	livestock employed in support of the family from ad valorem taxation						
23	pursuant to the provisions of Section 6 of Article X of the Oklahoma						
24	Constitution, the salary of all county officers named in paragraph 1						

1	of Section 180.73 of this title may be increased from the applicable						
2	basic salary named in Section 180.74 of this title, for the factor						
3	of service-ability, as defined in Section 180.71 of this title <u>;</u>						
4	provided that by a majority vote, the county commissioners, at a						
5	public meeting, agree there are sufficient revenues in the current						
6	budget to accept the increases provided in this section, according						
7	to the following scale:						
8	1. To the basic salary:						
9	a. add the product of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) times						
10	each Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) of revenue						
11	authorized to be collected for county purposes, or						
12	major fraction thereof until the amount of such						
13	revenue equals Seven Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars						
14	(\$750,000.00),						
15	b. thereafter add the product of One Hundred Dollars						
16	(\$100.00) times each additional Fifty Thousand Dollars						
17	(\$50,000.00) of revenue authorized to be collected for						
18	county purposes, or major fraction thereof until the						
19	amount of such revenue equals Five Million Dollars						
20	(\$5,000,000.00),						
21	c. thereafter add the product of One Hundred Twenty-five						
22	Dollars (\$125.00) times each additional Seventy						
23	Thousand Dollars (\$70,000.00) of revenue authorized to						
24	be collected for county purposes, or major fraction

1 thereof until the amount of such revenue equals Twenty 2 Million Dollars (\$20,000,000.00), and thereafter as to all additional revenue which is 3 d. 4 authorized to be collected for county purposes add the 5 product of One Hundred Twenty-five Dollars (\$125.00) times each additional Two Hundred Thousand Dollars 6 7 (\$200,000.00) of such revenue, or major fraction thereof; and 8 9 2. The salary of each county officer shall be additionally 10 increased from the basic salary named in Section 180.74 of this 11 title, and the additions to the basic salary as provided in this 12 section, for population or service load according to the following scale: 13 14 the product of Twelve Dollars and fifty cents (\$12.50) a. 15 times each one thousand (1,000) population, or major 16 fraction thereof until a population of seventy-five 17 thousand (75,000) is reached, 18 b. thereafter the product of Twelve Dollars and fifty 19 cents (\$12.50) times each additional five thousand 20 (5,000) population, or major fraction thereof until a 21 population of one hundred fifty thousand (150,000) is 22 reached, and 23 24

1 thereafter add the product of Twelve Dollars and fifty с. 2 cents (\$12.50) times each additional ten thousand 3 (10,000) population, or major fraction thereof. 4 This section shall not reduce the present salary of any Β. 5 county officer in Oklahoma during their present term of office. 6 C. As used in this section, "major fraction thereof" means any amount greater than one-half (1/2). 7

8 SECTION 6. AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 2011, Section 180.83, is 9 amended to read as follows:

10 Section 180.83 The date on which changes in the salaries and 11 rates of pay for county officers and their deputies, aides and 12 assistants under this act due to changes in population or the amount 13 of revenue authorized to be collected for county purposes in any 14 county shall take effect, shall be as of, on and after the first day 15 of July of each fiscal year January based upon the population as 16 shown by the latest Federal Decennial Census for the State of 17 Oklahoma, and the total amount of revenue authorized to be collected 18 from the millage rate levied against the taxable valuation of 19 property within the county which is apportioned for county purposes 20 pursuant to subsection (a) of Section 9 of Article X of the Oklahoma 21 Constitution for such current fiscal year.

22SECTION 7.REPEALER19 O.S. 2011, Sections 180.63e and23180.77, are hereby repealed.
