9	180.74 and 180.83, which relate to county officer salaries; modifying basic salary range for county
10	officers; directing county budget board members set basic salaries in certain circumstances; modifying
11	date in which certain salary schedules take effect; and providing an effective date.

15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 2011, Section 180.62, is
17	amended to read as follows:
18	Section 180.62 A. The basic salaries of county officers upon
19	which all salaries and future increases or decreases thereof shall
20	be computed, shall be as follows:
21	1. In every county having a net valuation of all tangible
22	taxable property, as defined in Sections 180.58 and 180.59 of this
23	title, of Forty Million Dollars (\$40,000,000.00) or less, the basic
24	salary of each of the county officers named in paragraph 1 of

1	Section 180.61 of this title shall not be less than Nineteen
2	Thousand Dollars (\$19,000.00) per annum nor shall it exceed Thirty-
3	nine Thousand Dollars (\$39,000.00) per annum;
4	2. In every county having a net valuation of all tangible
5	taxable property, as defined in Sections 180.58 and 180.59 of this
6	title, of more than Forty Million Dollars (\$40,000,000.00) but not
7	more than Eighty Million Dollars (\$80,000,000.00), the basic salary
8	of each of the county officers named in paragraph 1 of Section
9	180.61 of this title shall not be less than Twenty-two Thousand Five
10	Hundred Dollars (\$22,500.00) per annum nor shall it exceed Forty-two
11	Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$42,500.00) per annum;
12	3. In every county having a net valuation of all tangible
13	taxable property, as defined in Sections 180.58 and 180.59 of this
14	title, of more than Eighty Million Dollars (\$80,000,000.00) but not
15	more than Three Hundred Million Dollars (\$300,000,000.00), the basic
16	salary of each of the county officers named in paragraph 1 of
17	Section 180.61 of this title shall not be less than Twenty-four
18	Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$24,500.00) per annum nor shall it
19	exceed Forty-four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$44,500.00) per
20	annum;
21	4. In every county having a net valuation of all tangible
22	taxable property, as defined in Sections 180.58 and 180.59 of this
23	title, of more than Three Hundred Million Dollars (\$300,000,000.00)
24	but not more than Six Hundred Million Dollars (\$600,000,000.00), the

1 basic salary of each of the county officers named in paragraph 1 of Section 180.61 of this title shall not be less than Twenty-two 2 3 Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$22,500.00) per annum nor shall it 4 exceed Forty-two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$42,500.00) per 5 annum; and 6 5. In every county having a net valuation of all tangible 7 taxable property, as defined in Sections 180.58 and 180.59 of this title, of more than Six Hundred Million Dollars (\$600,000,000.00), 8 9 the basic salary of each of the county officers named in paragraph 1 10 of Section 180.61 of this title shall not be less than Nineteen Thousand Dollars (\$19,000.00) per annum nor shall it exceed Thirty-11 12 nine Thousand Dollars (\$39,000.00) per annum not be less than 13 Nineteen Thousand Dollars (\$19,000.00) per annum nor shall they 14 exceed Forty-four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$44,500.00) per 15 annum. 16 The board of county commissioners, or if the county has Β. 17 elected to come under the County Budget Act, the budget board 18 members of the county, shall set the salaries for all elected county 19 officials within the limits allowed by law. 20 С. The annual salaries fixed by this act shall be paid either 21 monthly or twice a month, by order of the board of county 22 commissioners, for each month or fraction thereof the incumbent 23 lawfully occupies and holds title to such office.

1SECTION 2.AMENDATORY19 O.S. 2011, Section 180.68, is2amended to read as follows:

Section 180.68 The date on which changes in the salaries and 3 rates of pay for county officers and their deputies, aides and 4 5 assistants under this act due to changes in population or valuation in any county shall take effect, shall be as of, on and after the 6 7 first day of July of each fiscal year January based upon the population as shown by the latest Federal Decennial Census for the 8 9 State of Oklahoma, and the total net assessed valuations of tangible 10 properties for such year as shown by the official certificate which 11 the county assessor files with the county excise board for the 12 purpose of computing appropriations and levies for such current 13 fiscal year.

14SECTION 3.AMENDATORY19 O.S. 2011, Section 180.74, is15amended to read as follows:

Section 180.74 A. The basic salaries of county officers upon which all salaries and future increases or decreases thereof shall be computed, shall be as follows:

19 1. In every county having a service-ability factor, as defined 20 in Section 180.71 of this title, of Four Hundred Thousand Dollars 21 (\$400,000.00) or less, the basic salary of each of the county 22 officers named in Section 180.73 of this title shall not be less 23 than Nineteen Thousand Dollars (\$19,000.00) per annum nor shall it 24 exceed Thirty-nine Thousand Dollars (\$39,000.00) per annum;

1	2. In every county having a service-ability factor, as defined
2	in Section 180.71 of this title, of more than Four Hundred Thousand
3	Dollars (\$400,000.00) but not more than Eight Hundred Thousand
4	Dollars (\$800,000.00), the basic salary of each of the county
5	officers named in Section 180.73 of this title shall not be less
6	than Twenty-two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$22,500.00) per annum
7	nor shall it exceed Forty-two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars
8	(\$42,500.00) per annum;
9	3. In every county having a service-ability factor, as defined

11	Dollars (\$800,000.00) but not more than Three Million Dollars
12	(\$3,000,000.00), the basic salary of each of the county officers
13	named in Section 180.73 of this title shall not be less than Twenty-
14	four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$24,500.00) per annum nor shall
15	it exceed Forty-four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$44,500.00) per
16	annum;
17	4. In every county having a service-ability factor, as defined
18	in Section 180.71 of this title, of more than Three Million Dollars
19	(\$3,000,000.00) but not more than Ten Million Dollars
20	(\$10,000,000.00), the basic salary of each of the county officers
21	named in Section 180.73 of this title shall not be less than Twenty-
22	two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$22,500.00) per annum nor shall
23	it exceed Forty-two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$42,500.00) per
24	annum; and

1	5. In every county having a service-ability factor, as defined
2	in Section 180.71 of this title, of more than Ten Million Dollars
3	(\$10,000,000.00), the basic salary of each of the county officers
4	named in Section 180.73 of this title shall not be less than
5	Nineteen Thousand Dollars (\$19,000.00) per annum nor shall it exceed
6	Thirty-nine Thousand Dollars (\$39,000.00) per annum not be less than
7	Nineteen Thousand Dollars (\$19,000.00) per annum nor shall they
8	exceed Forty-four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$44,500.00) per

18	SECTION 4. AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 2011, Section 180.83, is
19	amended to read as follows:
20	Section 180.83 The date on which changes in the salaries and
21	rates of pay for county officers and their deputies, aides and
22	assistants under this act due to changes in population or the amount
23	of revenue authorized to be collected for county purposes in any
24	county shall take effect, shall be as of, on and after the first day

1	of July of each fiscal year <u>January</u> based upon the population as
2	shown by the latest Federal Decennial Census for the State of
3	Oklahoma, and the total amount of revenue authorized to be collected
4	from the millage rate levied against the taxable valuation of
5	property within the county which is apportioned for county purposes
6	pursuant to subsection (a) of Section 9 of Article X of the Oklahoma
7	Constitution for such current fiscal year.
8	SECTION 5. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
