13	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 187.3 of Title 21, unless there
15	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
16	A. It shall be unlawful for any state employee, employee of a
17	school district or any other person to knowingly or willfully use a
18	state or school district telephone, electronic mail or other state
19	or school district equipment, property or services for political
20	advocacy.
21	B. No state employee, employee of a school district or any
22	other person shall be compelled to participate in political
23	advocacy.

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        C. Any person who violates the provisions of this section
    shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a
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    fine of One Hundred Dollars ($100.00). For purposes of this
    section, "political advocacy" means any activity to support or
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    oppose:
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        1. Legislation;
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        2. The election of a candidate for office;
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        3. A particular political party; or
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        4.
            Initiative, referenda or state questions.
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        SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
