An Act relating to state employees; authorizing state agencies to offer voluntary payments for unused accrued annual leave to eligible employees; directing Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services to appoint certain committee to study policy and develop rules; authorizing promulgation of rules; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 840-2.20D of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. State agencies are hereby authorized, at their discretion, up to two times annually, to offer their employees an option to voluntarily elect to be paid for a maximum of two hundred (200) hours of unused accrued annual leave. This program shall be optional for all eligible employees, and the agency may choose the monthly pay period in which to provide such payment. The employee must retain one hundred twenty (120) hours of annual leave after the payment is made.

1	B. The Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise
2	Services shall appoint a committee, chaired by the Director or a
3	designee, consisting of any number of employees representing any
4	state agency the Director deems appropriate, to study and develop a
5	policy and rules necessary to implement the program pursuant to
6	subsection A of this section. The committee shall solicit input
7	from state agencies and determine policies to establish employee
8	eligibility and any other relevant requirements.
9	C. The Office of Management and Enterprise Services is
10	authorized and directed to promulgate administrative rules necessary
11	to implement the provisions of this act.
12	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
