16	Section 1014. A. The punishment of death shall be carried out
17	by the administration of a lethal quantity of a drug or drugs until
18	death is pronounced by a licensed physician according to accepted
19	standards of medical practice.
20	B. If the execution of the sentence of death as provided in
21	subsection A of this section is held unconstitutional by an
22	appellate court of competent jurisdiction or is otherwise
23	unavailable, then the sentence of death shall be carried out by
24	nitrogen hypoxia.
