7	An Act relating to mental health; directing the Board of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services to promulgate rules for certification of Problem Gambling Treatment Counselors; providing that rules include criteria for certification and renewal; providing for application for certification; authorizing the Board to establish application and renewal fees; limiting use of title as Problem Gambling Treatment Counselor; providing for grounds for revocation, suspension or nonrenewal of certification; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.						
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16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:						
17	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified						
18	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3-322a of Title 43A, unless						
19	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:						
20	A. The Board of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services						
21	shall promulgate rules and standards for certification of Problem						
22	Gambling Treatment Counselors who are:						
23	1. Employed by the state;						

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- 2. Employed by behavioral services providers contracting with the state to provide behavioral health services;
- 3. Employed by a tribe or tribal facility that provides behavioral health services; or

- 4. Employed by an Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs or a United States Department of Veterans Affairs facility.
- B. Such rules and standards shall address criteria for certification and renewal, including minimum education requirements, examination and supervision requirements, continuing education requirements, and rules of professional conduct.
- C. Application for certification as a Problem Gambling

  Treatment Counselor shall be made to the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services on prescribed forms authorized by the Department. The Board, or the Commissioner of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services upon delegation by the Board, may certify the Problem Gambling Treatment Counselor for a period of two (2) years subject to renewal as provided in the rules promulgated by the Board.
- D. The Board is authorized to establish an application and renewal fee of no more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) to defray the costs incurred in the certification process.
- E. Problem Gambling Treatment Counselors certified by the Board or the Commissioner shall only use the title "Problem Gambling Treatment Counselor" if employed by the state, employed by

- 12 | 3. Clinical social worker;
- 4. Professional counselor;

- 16 7. Alcohol and drug counselor.
- G. Failure to comply with the rules and standards promulgated
- 18 by the Board shall be grounds for revocation, suspension or
- 19 | nonrenewal of certification.
- 20 H. No Problem Gambling Treatment Counselor shall operate or
- 21 | continue to operate as a Problem Gambling Treatment Counselor unless
- 22 | the Problem Gambling Treatment Counselor complies with the rules
- 23 promulgated by the Board and is certified as required by this
- 24 | section.
