| 1 | B. <u>A registered apprentice working under the supervision of a</u> |
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| 2 | mechanical contractor may sit for any journeyman license |

10 C. All licenses shall be nontransferable. No license shall be 11 issued for longer than one (1) year and all licenses shall expire on 12 the last day in the birth month of the licensee. Licenses renewed 13 more than thirty (30) days following the date of expiration may only 14 be renewed upon application and payment of the required fees and 15 payment of any penalty for late renewal, as shall be established by 16 the Board. No journeyman or contractor license shall be renewed 17 unless the licensee has completed the required hours of continuing 18 education as determined by the Committee. Persons who are licensed 19 as contractors under the Mechanical Licensing Act may have their 20 license placed on inactive status by paying the annual renewal fee 21 and eliminating the bonding and insurance requirements. No late fee 22 shall be charged to renew a license which expired while the 23 applicant was in military service, if application is made within one (1) year of discharge from the military service. 24
