6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to public buildings; requiring baby  
8 changing tables in certain state and municipal  
9 buildings; providing for codification; and providing  
10 an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 334 of Title 61, unless there is  
14 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 All new construction of state and municipal buildings open to  
16 the public commenced after January 1, 2020, and all renovations and  
17 replacements of existing public state and municipal buildings open  
18 to the public commenced after January 1, 2020, shall include at  
19 least one baby changing table. This section shall only apply to  
20 renovations and replacements if the renovation or replacement  
21 exceeds fifty percent (50%) of the value of the state or municipal  
22 building. If a baby changing table is not accessible in such a  
23 building or facility to both men and women, the building code shall  
24 require that the building or facility be equipped with at least one

1 such table accessible to men and at least one such table accessible  
2 to women.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
