7	An Act relating to the State Board of Corrections; amending 57 O.S. 2011, Sections 503, 504 and 506, as
8	last amended by Section 2, Chapter 386, O.S.L. 2016 (57 O.S. Supp. 2018, Section 506), which relate to
9	the State Board of Corrections; making Board an advisory body; transferring duties to the Executive
10	Director; modifying powers and duties of the Board; authorizing Governor to appoint Director; providing
11	for determination of compensation; and providing an effective date.

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15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 57 O.S. 2011, Section 503, is
17	amended to read as follows:
18	Section 503. There is hereby created the State Board of
19	Corrections which shall be <del>the governing board of the Department</del> <u>an</u>
20	advisory body to the Director of Corrections herein created. All
21	duties and powers of the Board shall be transferred to the Director.
22	Any provision in statute that provides to the Board authority that
23	is not advisory in nature shall be deemed to grant the duty or power
24	to the Director. The Board shall consist of seven (7) members who

1 shall be appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of 2 the Senate. One member shall be appointed from each congressional 3 district and any remaining members shall be appointed from the state 4 at large. However, when congressional districts are redrawn each 5 member appointed prior to July 1 of the year in which such modification becomes effective shall complete the current term of 6 7 office and appointments made after July 1 of the year in which such modification becomes effective shall be based on the redrawn 8 9 districts. Appointments made after July 1 of the year in which such 10 modification becomes effective shall be from any redrawn districts 11 which are not represented by a board member until such time as each 12 of the modified congressional districts are represented by a board 13 member. No appointments may be made after July 1 of the year in 14 which such modification becomes effective if such appointment would 15 result in more than two members serving from the same modified 16 district. The terms of office of two members shall expire on March 17 15, 1969, and each six (6) years thereafter; the terms of two 18 members shall expire on March 15, 1971, and each six (6) years 19 thereafter; and the terms of three members shall expire on March 15, 20 1973, and each six (6) years thereafter. Not more than four members 21 of the Board shall be of the same political party. Any member of 22 the Board may be removed from office in the manner provided by law 23 for the removal of officers not subject to impeachment. Vacancies 24 on the Board shall be filled for the unexpired term.

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1SECTION 2.AMENDATORY57 O.S. 2011, Section 504, is2amended to read as follows:

Section 504. (a) <u>A.</u> The Board shall elect from its members a
chairman, vice chairman and a secretary. It <u>Director of Corrections</u>
shall adopt rules and regulations for its government and may adopt
an official seal for the Department. <u>Members shall be reimbursed</u>
for travel expenses, as provided in the State Travel Reimbursement
Act while attending meetings of the Board or while performing other
official duties.

10 (b) <u>B.</u> The <u>Board</u> <u>Director</u> shall have the following powers and 11 duties:

12 (1) <u>1.</u> To establish policies for the operation of the 13 Department;

14 (2) 2. To establish and maintain such institutions as are 15 necessary or convenient for the operation of programs for the 16 education, training, vocational education and rehabilitation of 17 prisoners under the jurisdiction of the Department;

18 (3) 3. To lease, from time to time, without restriction as to 19 terms, any property which said Board Director shall determine 20 advisable to more fully carry into effect the operation of prison 21 industries;

22 (4) <u>4.</u> To acquire, construct, extend, improve, maintain and 23 operate any and all facilities of all kinds which in the judgment of 24

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1 the Board Director shall be necessary or convenient to foster the 2 prison industries program;

3 (5) <u>5.</u> To require the Director and any other personnel of the 4 Department, when deemed necessary by the Board Governor, to give 5 bond for the faithful performance of their duties;

## (6) To appoint and fix the salary of the Director;

7 (7) <u>6.</u> To enter into contracts with private prison contractors; 8 and

9 (8) 7. To provide training to employees of private prison
10 contractors and other governmental entities on a fee basis.

SECTION 3. AMENDATORY 57 O.S. 2011, Section 506, as last amended by Section 2, Chapter 386, O.S.L. 2016 (57 O.S. Supp. 2018, Section 506), is amended to read as follows:

14 Section 506. There is hereby created the position of Director 15 of Corrections. The Director shall be qualified for such position 16 by character, knowledge, skill, ability, education, training and 17 successful administrative experience and shall have five (5) years 18 of professional level work. The Director of Corrections shall be 19 appointed by the Board of Corrections, with the advice and consent 20 of the Senate and shall be subject to removal by a vote of the 21 majority of the entire Board or in the manner provided by law for 22 the removal of officers not subject to impeachment Governor, with 23 the advice and consent of the Senate, and shall serve at the 24 pleasure of the Governor and may be removed or replaced without

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1	cause. Compensation for the Director shall be determined pursuant
2	to Section 3601.2 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
3	SECTION 4. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
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
