NEW LAW 15 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows: 16 The Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education are encouraged 17 to use monies appropriated pursuant to the provisions of Section 3 18 of Article XIII-A of the Oklahoma Constitution each year in order to 19 support entrepreneurship with special emphasis upon providing such 20 support to minority communities in the state. The support should 21 include, but not be limited to, business organization, creation of 22 business plans or business models, accounting, business financing 23 options and such other topics that would be of assistance to persons

who might consider establishing a business in the state with the

1 attendant benefits of job creation, capital investment, broadening 2 of the state and local tax base, home ownership, generational wealth transfer and the other attributes of developing and supporting an 3 4 entrepreneurial economy within the State of Oklahoma. The Oklahoma 5 State Regents for Higher Education are encouraged to give due 6 consideration to the allocation of resources to institutions within 7 The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education that have a high 8 likelihood of effective service delivery to minority populations or 9 communities. 10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2015. 11 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation 12 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby 13 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and

be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
