NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-580 of Title 63, unless there 20 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 2.1 1. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a 22 revolving fund for the State Department of Health to be designated 23 the "Pediatric Cancer Research and Resources Revolving Fund". 24 fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year

limitations, and shall consist of all monies designated for deposit to the fund by law and any public donations otherwise eligible for deposit in such fund. All monies accruing to the credit of said fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the State Department of Health for the purposes of:

- a. providing grants to entities engaging in research related to pediatric cancer, and
- b. providing grants to entities assisting families confronted with financial challenges associated with pediatric cancer treatment.
- 2. Expenditures from said fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for approval and payment.
- B. The State Department of Health shall establish eligibility and application requirements for the award of grants authorized under the provisions of this section. In no event shall the Department award grants in excess of the unencumbered balance of the Pediatric Cancer Research and Resources Revolving Fund.
- C. The State Department of Health shall promulgate rules for the proper administration of the Pediatric Cancer Research and Resources Revolving Fund in accordance with the requirements of this section.
 - SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2023.

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1	SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
2	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
3	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
4	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
