inspection by the parents or guardians of students enrolled in the school, members of the board of education of the school district,

members of the State Board of Education, employees of the State

Department of Education, and legislators.

- B. Each school district shall develop and adopt policies pertaining to the inspection of professional development material and instructional materials in consultation with parents and guardians material. The policies shall include procedures for granting a request by a parent or guardian for reasonable access to professional development material and instructional material within a reasonable period of time after the request is received. If the professional development material or instructional material being requested is protected by copyright law, the school district shall provide reasonable access for the material to be inspected on school property. The school district may limit unauthorized duplication or dissemination of the material in compliance with applicable copyright laws.
 - C. For the purposes of this section, "instructional:
- 1. "Instructional material" means instructional content that is provided to a student, regardless of the format, including printed or representational materials, <u>library materials</u>, audio-visual materials, and materials in electronic or digital formats; and
