NEW LAW 15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3251 of Title 70, unless there 16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 17 Α. It is the intent of the Legislature, that the Oklahoma State 18 Regents for Higher Education establish a comprehensive transition 19 and postsecondary program for students with intellectual 20 disabilities which shall be offered by institutions within The 21 Oklahoma State System of Higher Education. 22 The comprehensive transition and postsecondary program for В. 23 students with intellectual disabilities shall be a degree, 24 certificate, or nondegree program that:

- 1. Is offered by a public institution that is a member of The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education;
- 2. Is designed to support students with intellectual disabilities who are seeking to continue academic, career, technical, and independent living instruction at an institution of higher learning to prepare for gainful employment;
  - 3. Includes an advising and curriculum structure; and
- 4. Requires students with intellectual disabilities to participate in not less than a half-time basis, as determined by the institution, with this participation focusing on academic components and occurring through one or more of the following activities:
  - a. regular enrollment in credit-bearing courses with nondisabled students offered by the institution,
  - b. auditing or participating in courses with nondisabled students offered by the institution for which the student does not receive academic credit,
  - c. enrollment in noncredit-bearing, nondegree courses with nondisabled students, and
  - d. participation in internships or work-based training in settings with nondisabled individuals.
- C. The State Regents shall establish procedures and criteria, in accordance with the Federal Higher Education Opportunity Act of 2008, Public Law 110-315, for students with intellectual

- 1 disabilities participating in a comprehensive transition and 2 postsecondary program to:
  - 1. Be eligible for, apply, and receive Pell Grants,
    Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grants and Work Study jobs; and
  - 2. Enroll in and attend an institution of higher education in The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education without meeting regular admission and attendance requirements.
  - D. The State Regents shall seek funding for grants to award to institutions to assist in establishing a comprehensive transition and postsecondary program for students with intellectual disabilities at the institution.
  - E. For purposes of this section, a "student with an intellectual disability" means a student:
  - 1. With mental retardation or a cognitive impairment characterized by significant limitations in:
    - a. intellectual and cognitive functioning, and
    - b. adaptive behavior as expressed in conceptual, social, and practical adaptive skills; and
  - 2. Who is currently, or was formerly, eligible for a free appropriate public education under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA).
- SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
