| 15 | SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  |
| 16 | in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 334 of Title 61, unless there is  |
| 17 | created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:   |
| 18 | A. The Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall   |
| 19 | display the national motto of the United States in a prominently  |
| 20 | visible location in all state buildings. The placement and size of  |
| 21 | the display shall be in keeping with the placement and size of the  |
| 22 | display of the national motto in the United States Capitol Visitor  |
| 23 | Center in a manner proportional to the state building where the   |
| 24 | display is placed. The Office of Management and Enterprise Services   |

| 3  | B. In the event that the legality or constitutionality of the                               |
| 4  | display is challenged in a court of law, the Oklahoma Attorney                              |

| 7  | C. The display of the national motto shall not be construed to                              |
| 8  | mean that the State of Oklahoma favors any particular religion or                           |
