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13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:	
14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2011, Section 142.2, as	
15	last amended by Section 1, Chapter 136, O.S.L. 2018 (63 O.S. Supp.	
16	2018, Section 142.2), is amended to read as follows:	
17	Section 142.2 As used in the Oklahoma Underground Facilities	
18	Damage Prevention Act:	
19	1. "Certified project" means a project where the public agency	
20	responsible for the public project, as part of its procedure,	
21	certifies that the project right-of-way is free and clear of	
22	underground facilities or wherein the public agency responsible for	
23	such project, as part of its procedure, notifies all persons	
24	determined by the public agency to have underground facilities	

1 located within the construction right-of-way and certifies that all
2 known underground facilities are duly located or noted on the
3 engineering drawings for the project;

2. "Damage" means any impact upon or removal of support from an
underground facility as a result of explosion, excavation or
demolition which according to the operating practices of the
operator of the underground facilities would necessitate the repair
thereof;

9 3. "Demolish" means to wreck, raze, render, move or remove a
10 structure by means of any equipment or explosive;

11 4. "Demolition" means the act or operation of demolishing a 12 structure;

13 5. "Excavate" means to dig, compress or remove earth, rock or 14 other materials in or on the ground by use of mechanized equipment 15 or blasting, including, but not necessarily limited to, augering, 16 boring, backfilling, drilling, grading, pile driving, plowing in, 17 pulling in, trenching, tunneling and plowing; provided, however, 18 that neither:

a. the moving of earth by tools manipulated only by human
 or animal power, <u>except in a private or public</u>
 easement or right-of-way, nor

b. any form of cultivation for agricultural purposes, nor
 any augering, dozing by noncommercial dozer operators

15	6. "Excavat:	ion" means the act or operation of excavating;	
16	7. "Excavato	or" means a person or public agency that intends to	
17	excavate or demo	lish within the State of Oklahoma;	
18	8. "Notifica	ation center" means the statewide center currently	
19	known as the Okla	ahoma One-Call System, Inc., which has as one of its	
20	purposes to receive notification of planned excavation and		
21	demolition in a specified area from excavators, and to disseminate		
22	such notification of planned excavation or demolition to operators		
23	who are members and participants;		
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9. "Operator" shall mean and include any person or public
 agency owning or operating underground facilities;

10. "Permitted project" means a project where a permit for the work to be performed must be issued by a state or federal agency and, as a prerequisite to receiving such permit, the applicant must locate all underground facilities in the area of the work and in the vicinity of any blasting and notify each owner of such underground facilities;

9 11. "Person" includes any individual, partnership, corporation, 10 association, cooperative, trust or other entity, including a person 11 engaged as a contractor by a public agency, but not including a 12 public agency;

"Preengineered project" means a public project wherein the 13 12. 14 public agency responsible for such project, as part of its 15 engineering and contract procedures, holds a meeting prior to the 16 commencement of any construction work on such project in which all 17 persons, determined by the public agency to have underground 18 facilities located within the construction area of the project, are 19 invited to attend and given an opportunity to verify or inform the 20 public agency of the location of their underground facilities, if 21 any, within the construction area and where the location of all 22 known underground facilities are duly located or noted on the 23 engineering drawing and specifications for the project;

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1 13. "Public agency" means the state or any board, commission or 2 agency of the state;

14. "Routine maintenance" means the grading of roads and barrow or drainage ditches, the removal and replacement of pavement, including excavation relating thereto and the installation and maintenance of drainage and bridge facilities, signs, guardrails, and electrical and communications facilities in or on the public rights-of-way by a public agency; and

9 15. "Underground facility" means any underground line, cable, 10 facility, system and appurtenances thereto, for producing, storing, 11 conveying, transmitting or distributing communication (including 12 voice, video, or data information), electricity, power, light, heat, 13 intrastate and interstate gas pipelines, as described in 49 CFR Part 14 192.1, intrastate and interstate hazardous liquid or carbon dioxide 15 pipelines, as described in 49 CFR Part 195.1, water (including storm 16 water), steam, sewage and other commodities and any oil and gas 17 pipeline located in a public right-of-way.

18 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
