18	A. Effective July 1, 2023, any individual person that purchases

- C. The Oklahoma Department of Transportation shall require a copy of the documents containing the purchase price information for the electric bicycle before issuing a rebate payment.
- D. For each fiscal year during which the rebate program is operative the total amount of rebates paid shall not exceed One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00).
 - SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2023.
- SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
