6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to state government; requiring state  
8 governmental entities organized within the executive  
9 branch of state government to include certain choices  
10 regarding natural persons in documents; providing  
11 exception; providing for codification; providing an  
12 effective date; and declaring an emergency.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 9501 of Title 74, unless there  
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 Each agency, board, commission, department, instrumentality or  
18 other entity organized within the executive branch of state  
19 government shall include, if applicable, on any form or other  
20 document used by the state governmental entity as part of a process  
21 for determining a natural person's identity a nonbinary option  
22 wherever options for male and female exist. The provisions of this  
23 section shall not be applicable to any form or document used by the

1 state governmental entity if gender information is not required or  
2 is not otherwise part of the content of the form or document.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2021.

4 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
5 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
6 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
7 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
