8 An Act relating to torts; permitting liability for
9 damages committed by a trespasser; authorizing
10 vicarious liability for person or entity that
11 compensates trespasser; providing for codification;
12 and providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 80.1 of Title 76, unless there
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A. A person who is arrested or convicted of trespass may be
18 held liable for any damages to personal or real property while
19 trespassing.

20 B. A person or entity that compensates or remunerates a person
21 for trespassing as described in subsection A of this section, may
22 also be held vicariously liable for any damages to personal or real
23 property committed by the person compensated or remunerated for
24 trespassing.
