12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 80.1 of Title 76, unless there  
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A. A person who is arrested or convicted of trespass may be  
17 held liable for any damages to personal or real property while  
18 trespassing.

19 B. A person or entity that compensates or remunerates a person  
20 for trespassing as described in subsection A of this section, may  
21 also be held vicariously liable for any damages to personal or real  
22 property committed by the person compensated or remunerated for  
23 trespassing.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
