A person who is arrested or convicted of trespass may be 17 held liable for any damages to personal or real property while 18 trespassing. 19 B. A person or entity that compensates or remunerates a person 20 for trespassing as described in subsection A of this section, may 21 also be held vicariously liable for any damages to personal or real 22 property committed by the person compensated or remunerated for 23 trespassing.
