10 House of Representatives; provided, whenever possible, no more than
11 two members shall be appointed from the same political party;

12 3. Three members of the Senate whose legislative districts 13 encompass some part of the territory in which the MKARNS is located 14 to be formally selected by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate; 15 provided, whenever possible, no more than two members shall be 16 appointed from the same political party;

17 4. One member from each of the three (3) Native American tribes18 that has ownership interest in the Arkansas Riverbed;

19 5. One member appointed by the Speaker of the House of 20 Representatives who shall represent a statewide business 21 organization;

6. One member appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate who shall represent a statewide agricultural organization; and

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7. One member appointed by the Governor who shall represent a 1 2 public port along the MKARNS.

The Tri-State Commission shall have the following duties: 4 1. To identify the resources available at the federal and state 5 levels for the proper maintenance of the physical assets which allow the MKARNS to fulfill its duties and responsibilities; 6
