15	A. It shall be considered a taking pursuant to Article 2 of the
16	Oklahoma Constitution and relevant statutes whenever a municipality,
17	county or other political subdivision, other than the Corporation
18	Commission, adopts or implements an ordinance, resolution, rule,
19	regulation or other form of official policy concerning oil and gas
20	operations that has the effect of:
21	1. Substantially interfering with the use and enjoyment of the
22	mineral estate, as defined in Section 802 of Title 52 of the
23	Oklahoma Statutes;

- 2. Imposing or enforcing a limitation that adversely impacts the use and development of minerals; or
- 3. Prohibiting access to develop the mineral estate, thereby substantially increasing the costs of the oil and gas operations, or thereby substantially reducing the fair market value of the mineral estate.
- B. The provisions of this section shall not apply to any ordinance, resolution, rule, regulation or other form of official policy adopted or implemented prior to December 31, 2014.
- SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
