14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 61 O.S. 2021, Section 227, is
15	amended to read as follows:
16	Section 227. A. 1. This act shall not apply to:
17	a. highway construction,
18	b. railroad construction, or
19	c. turnpike construction <u>, or</u>
20	d. municipal road construction.
21	2. Except as the following may be a portion of a construction
22	contract as defined in Section $\frac{2}{222}$ of this $\frac{1}{222}$ this act
23	shall not apply to:
24	a. roads,

1 b. bridges, 2 utilities, C. traffic control, 3 d. drainage construction, 4 е. 5 f. sanitary sewer construction, or waterline construction. 6 g. This act shall not apply to any contract relating to a 7 single-, two-, three-, or four-family dwelling. 8 9 The following are against the public policy of this state and are void and unenforceable: 10 A provision, covenant, clause or understanding in, 11 12 collateral to or affecting a construction contract that makes the 13 contract subject to the laws of another state or that requires any litigation, arbitration or other dispute resolution proceeding 14 arising from the contract to be conducted in another state; and 15 2. A provision, covenant, clause or understanding in, 16 collateral to or affecting a construction contract that disallows or 17 alters the rights of any prime contractor, subcontractor, sub-18 subcontractor, or material supplier to receive and enforce any and 19 all rights under this act. 20 SECTION 2.
