7 An Act relating to schools; providing certain  
8 definition; requiring State Board of Education to  
9 adopt certain statewide system of college and career  
10 planning tools; requiring students entering ninth  
11 grade by certain school year to complete certain  
12 plan; setting forth requirements to include in plan;  
13 requiring system to be implemented under certain  
14 schedule; providing for certain construction;  
15 providing that plan for certain students coordinate  
16 with other program; providing for codification; and  
17 providing an effective date.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1210.508-4 of Title 70, unless  
21 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

22 A. As used in this section, "Individual Career and Academic  
23 Plan (ICAP)" means an individualized plan developed by the student  
24 and the student's parent or legal guardian, in collaboration with  
their school counselors, school administrators, teachers and other  
school personnel, that is used to help establish personalized  
academic and career goals, explore postsecondary career and

1 educational opportunities, align coursework and curriculum, apply to  
2 postsecondary institutions, secure financial aid and ultimately  
3 enter the workforce.

4 B. As part of the multimeasures approach to high school  
5 graduation recommended by the State Board of Education, pursuant to  
6 Section 5 of House Bill No. 3218 passed by the Legislature in the  
7 2nd Session of the 55th Legislature, the Board shall adopt a new  
8 statewide system of college and career planning tools which shall be  
9 known as the "Individual Career Academic Plan (ICAP)". The Board  
10 shall work cooperatively with school districts to incorporate the  
11 ICAP into graduation requirements.

12 1. Beginning with students entering the ninth grade in the  
13 2019-2020 school year, each student shall be required to complete  
14 the process of an ICAP in order to graduate from a public high  
15 school with a standard diploma. Each year thereafter, students  
16 shall annually update their ICAP. The ICAP shall include, but not  
17 be limited to:

- 18 a. career- and college-interest surveys,
- 19 b. written postsecondary and workforce goals and  
20 information of progress towards these goals,
- 21 c. intentional sequence of courses that reflect progress  
22 toward the postsecondary goal,
- 23 d. the student's academic progress, including courses  
24 taken, assessment scores, any remediation or credit

1 recovery and any Advanced Placement, International  
2 Baccalaureate; concurrent or dual enrollment credits  
3 earned and/or career certificate(s), certification(s),  
4 or endorsements, and

- 5 e. experience in-service learning and/or work environment  
6 activities.

7 2. The ICAP system shall be implemented according to the  
8 following schedule:

- 9 a. for the 2017-2018 school year, the Oklahoma State  
10 Department of Education shall work with school  
11 districts, the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher  
12 Education and the Oklahoma State Board of Career and  
13 Technology Education to develop individual career  
14 academic planning tools for students in grades six  
15 through twelve,
- 16 b. for the 2018-2019 school year, the Department shall  
17 incorporate the ICAP as described in paragraph 1 of  
18 this subsection on a pilot program basis, and
- 19 c. for the 2019-2020 school year, and each school year  
20 thereafter, school districts shall fully incorporate  
21 and put into operation the ICAP as described in  
22 paragraph 1 of this subsection for all students  
23 entering the ninth grade.

1 C. Nothing in this section shall be construed to prevent a  
2 district from implementing the ICAP for students in earlier grades.

3 D. ICAPs for students with disabilities, as defined in the  
4 Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA), P.L. No. 105-17,  
5 shall take into account and work in cooperation with the student's  
6 individualized education program (IEP) or Section 504 Plan as  
7 defined by the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, P.L. No. 93-112.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
