The horses brought by the Spanish 20 were pure Spanish Mustangs, a relatively small but tough breed of 21 horse. After the introduction of these horses to American Indian 22 tribes, the horses became essential to the tribes, and they began to 23 rely heavily on them for their travels during times of war and 24

1	hardship, as well as for hunting. In addition, the American Indian
2	tribes utilized the Colonial Spanish Mustang/Heritage Horse of
3	Oklahoma to traverse the Trail of Tears.
4	SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
5	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 98.20 of Title 25, unless there
6	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
7	The Colonial Spanish Mustang/Heritage Horse, a descendant of the
8	first horses brought to the Americas by the Spanish, is hereby
9	designated and adopted as the state horse of the State of Oklahoma.
10	SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
