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12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 10 O.S. 2011, Section 83, as last
14	amended by Section 1, Chapter 171, O.S.L. 2014 (10 O.S. Supp. 2014,
15	Section 83), is amended to read as follows:
16	Section 83. A. Both the mother of a child born out of wedlock
17	and an individual who has been legally determined to be the father
18	of a child by acknowledgment or by judicial or administrative order
19	are each liable for the support and education of the child.
20	B. 1. An action to establish or enforce the obligation of
21	support and education may be brought by either parent, or other
22	custodial person, or the guardian of the child, by the public
23	authority chargeable with the support of the child, or by the child
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2. An action to enforce this obligation of support may be
 brought within the time period specified by paragraph 8 of
 subsection A of Section 95 of Title 12 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

3. If the parental rights of a mother or father are terminated
in an adoption proceeding decree, the obligation to support the
child ceases for the parent whose rights were terminated. Child
support arrearages are not affected by the adoption of the child.

8 4. The court may order the payments made to either parent, 9 other custodial person, or the guardian of the child, or to some 10 other person, corporation or agency to administer under the 11 supervision of the court.

12 C. An individual who has been legally determined to be the 13 father of a child pursuant to the Uniform Parentage Act shall be 14 ordered to pay all or a portion of the costs of the birth and the 15 reasonable expenses of providing for the child, provided that 16 liability for support provided before the determination of paternity 17 shall be imposed for two (2) years preceding the filing of the 18 action. The mother shall be liable for the reasonable expenses of 19 providing for the child to the same extent as the father and subject 20 to the same limitation of liability for any time she does not have 21 custody of the child prior to the establishment of paternity or an 22 order for support.

D. The amount of child support and other support including
amounts provided for in subsection C of this section shall be

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1 ordered and reviewed in accordance with the child support guidelines 2 provided in Section 118 of Title 43 of the Oklahoma Statutes. 3 Interest shall accrue on the support amounts pursuant to Section 114 4 of Title 43 of the Oklahoma Statutes. 5 Е. If both the mother and the father agree to change the 6 surname of the child to that of the father, the court may order the 7 name changed. Upon receipt of an order changing the child's 8 surname, the State Department of Health, Division of Vital Records, 9 shall correct its records and amend the birth certificate to reflect 10 the name change. 11 SECTION 2.
