An Act relating to counties and county officers; amending 19 O.S. 2011, Section 517.1, as last amended by Section 8 of Enrolled House Bill No. 1189 of the 1st Session of the 56th Oklahoma Legislature, which relates to departmental records; providing time period that certain recordings from equipment attached to law enforcement officers shall be kept; and providing an effective date.

SUBJECT: County records

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 2011, Section 517.1, as last amended by Section 8 of Enrolled House Bill No. 1189 of the 1st Session of the 56th Oklahoma Legislature, is amended to read as follows:

Section 517.1 A. The governing body of each county may establish a length of time for the county to keep departmental records and authorize the sheriff to properly dispose of or digitize all records not specifically addressed in other statutes. ~~Such~~

B. Except as otherwise provided in this section, records shall be kept for a minimum of seven (7) years; provided, however, However, if the sheriff is the sole source for such records, the records shall be kept for a minimum of seven (7) years; provided, that any audio or video recordings from recording equipment attached to the person of a law enforcement officer that depict anything other than an officer-involved shooting, use of lethal force, incidents involving medical treatment, incidents where a written application is received for the preservation of the specific event, or upon request of the district attorney may be kept at a minimum of one (1) year to be determined by the county sheriff.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
