7 SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

8 An Act relating to public finance; amending 62 O.S.  
9 2011, Section 34.11.1.1, which relates to the  
10 Oklahoma State Finance Act; requiring online  
11 publication of certain data sets; providing for an  
12 exemption; amending Section 1, Chapter 254, O.S.L.  
13 2015 (68 O.S. Supp. 2015, Section 1354.36), which  
14 relates to sales tax levy ballots; modifying certain  
15 definition; and providing an effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 62 O.S. 2011, Section 34.11.1.1,  
18 is amended to read as follows:

19 Section 34.11.1.1 A. The Chief Information Officer shall  
20 source and submit to the State Governmental Technology Applications  
21 Review Board proposed state employee performance information  
22 metrics, convenience information sets and other data streams for  
23 possible publication on the ~~"data.ok.gov"~~ data.ok.gov website in  
24 accordance with guidelines established by Section 34.11.2 of ~~Title~~  
~~62 of the Oklahoma Statutes~~ this title.

1 B. The Chief Information Officer shall assist the State  
2 Governmental Technology Applications Review Board with developing  
3 performance metrics pursuant to the requirements of Section 34.27 of  
4 ~~Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes~~ this title.

5 C. The following data sets shall be placed online at the  
6 ~~"data.ok.gov"~~ data.ok.gov website:

7 1. All state expenditures which shall include, but not be  
8 limited to, the name and address of the recipient of the  
9 expenditure, amount of expenditure, entire description of item or  
10 service purchased, date of expenditure, agency making expenditure  
11 and account from which the expenditure is made;

12 2. A detailed listing of all state revolving funds and the  
13 amount contained in each fund to be updated on a monthly basis; ~~and~~

14 3. All spending data subject to publication by the School  
15 District Transparency Act; and

16 4. A comprehensive listing of the effective sales tax rate for  
17 each governmental entity located within the state.

18 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 254, O.S.L.  
19 2015 (68 O.S. Supp. 2015, Section 1354.36), is amended to read as  
20 follows:

21 Section 1354.36 After January 1, 2016, every sales tax levy  
22 submitted to county voters for approval shall embrace but one  
23 subject, which shall be clearly expressed on the ballot. For  
24 purposes of this section, "one subject" shall mean a ballot

1 proposition with only one sales tax levy for a specified purpose but  
2 may include multiple projects for that purpose.

3 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.

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
