15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 62 O.S. 2011, Section 34.11.1.1,
16	is amended to read as follows:

SECTION 2. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 254, O.S.L. 2015 (68 O.S. Supp. 2015, Section 1354.36), is amended to read as follows:

Section 1354.36 After January 1, 2016, every sales tax levy submitted to county voters for approval shall embrace but one subject, which shall be clearly expressed on the ballot. For purposes of this section, "one subject" shall mean a ballot

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1	proposition with only one sales tax levy for a specified purpose but
2	may include multiple projects for that purpose.
3	SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.
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
