15	A. A person commits the crime of mail theft or receipt of
16	stolen mail if the person intentionally:
17	1. Takes or by fraud or deception obtains mail from a post
18	office, postal station, mail receptacle, authorized depository or
19	mail carrier;
20	2. Removes the contents of any stolen mail;
21	3. Secretes, embezzles or destroys any stolen mail;
22	4. Takes or by fraud or deception obtains mail that has been
23	delivered to or left for collection on or adjacent to a mail
24	receptacle or authorized depository; or

5. Buys, receives, conceals or possesses stolen mail knowing
that the mail has been unlawfully taken or obtained.

3 B. Any person who violates the provisions of this section 4 shall, upon conviction, be quilty of a felony punishable by 5 imprisonment in the custody of the Department of Corrections for not 6 less than one (1) year, or by a fine of One Thousand Dollars 7 (\$1,000.00), or by both such fine and imprisonment. The conviction 8 of any person, as prescribed in this section, when the offense 9 occurs during the months of November or December shall result in the 10 doubling of the term of imprisonment, the fine or both imprisonment and fine. 11

12 C. As used in this section, "mail" includes letters, postcards, 13 packages and mail bags.

14 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
