10 AS INTRODUCED

11 An Act relating to motor vehicles; amending 47 O.S.
12 2011, Section 15-113, which relates to penalties for
13 parking in a disabled parking place; excluding
14 certain penalties for a person with a Purple Heart
15 recipient license plate; modifying penalty for
16 certain offense; and providing an effective date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 15-113, is
19 amended to read as follows:

20 Section 15-113. A. Any person who knowingly makes or procures
21 the making of a false statement in an application submitted pursuant
22 to Sections 15-111 through 15-113 of this title is guilty of a
23 misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine of Five
24

1 Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for each falsified statement. This
2 penalty shall be stated on all applications.

3 B. 1. Any person who has not been issued a physically disabled
4 parking placard pursuant to the provisions of Section 15-112 of this
5 title, a physically disabled license plate issued pursuant to the
6 provisions of Section 1135.1 of this title, a disabled veterans
7 license plate pursuant to the provisions of Section 1135.2 of this
8 title, a Purple Heart recipient license plate issued pursuant to the
9 provisions of Section 1135.2 of this title, a disability sticker
10 issued by the Department of Veterans Affairs and federal military
11 bases, or a physically disabled placard or license plate issued by
12 another state, and uses a placard, sticker, or license plate to park
13 in a disabled parking place is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon
14 conviction shall be punished by a fine of Five Hundred Dollars
15 (\$500.00). A person transporting a physically disabled person with
16 an authorized placard, sticker or license plate, as provided in
17 subsection A of Section 11-1007 of this title, shall be excluded
18 from the provisions of this section.

19 2. Any person who has been issued a physically disabled parking
20 placard pursuant to the provisions of Section 15-112 of this title,
21 a physically disabled license plate issued pursuant to the
22 provisions of Section 1135.1 of this title, ~~or~~ a disabled veterans
23 license plate pursuant to the provisions of Section 1135.2 of this
24 title or a Purple Heart recipient license plate issued pursuant to

1 the provisions of Section 1135.2 of this title, and knowingly allows
2 the placard or license plate to be used by a person not issued the
3 placard or license plate as described in paragraph 1 of this
4 subsection, is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be
5 punished by a fine of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00).

6 C. A person who knowingly makes a counterfeit physically
7 disabled parking placard or physically disabled license plate is
8 guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be punished by a
9 fine of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for each counterfeit placard
10 or license plate made by such person.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
