in this state. Employer includes the State of Oklahoma or a county,

city, district, authority, public corporation, or entity and any of their instrumentalities organized and existing under law, but does not include the federal government.

- B. Upon request of an employee who is a search and rescue volunteer accepted to participate in search and rescue activities by the county sheriff or other law enforcement entity, an employer may grant a leave of absence to the employee until release from the search and rescue activities permits the employee to resume the duties of employment.
- C. The regular employment position of an employee on leave of absence under this section is considered vacant only for the period of the leave of absence. The employee is not subject to removal or discharge from the position as a consequence of the leave of absence.
- D. Upon the termination of a leave of absence under this section, the employer shall restore the employee to the employee's position or an equivalent position without loss of seniority, vacation credits, sick leave credits, service credits under a pension plan, or any other employee benefit or right that had been earned at the time of the leave of absence.
- E. An employer is not required to pay wages or other monetary compensation to an employee during a leave of absence under this section.
