18	A. If condemnation proceedings are filed against the owner of
19	any real property or interest therein over which any corporation,
20	incorporated under the laws of this state, may desire to locate its
21	pipeline, utility line or other transmission line, the owner may
22	file at the time of the answer to the petition to appoint
23	commissioners, a request for judicial location exception to the
24	proposed location of the right-of-way through and over the property.

B. The respondent shall have fifteen (15) days to file a reply
 after the answer and request for judicial location exception are
 served.

C. Prior to appointing commissioners to inspect the property,
the court shall conduct a hearing to determine if an alternative
location for the right-of-way would be possible. In making this
judicial determination, the court shall consider the following:

8 1. Reasonable alternative locations or placements available for9 the right-of-way;

10 2. Reasonable obstacles presented by the alternative locations 11 compared to the originally proposed location set forth in the 12 petition;

13 3. Good-faith effort of the plaintiff in negotiating with the 14 property owner regarding the proposed location and any alternative 15 location; and

4. Topographical or historic aspects of the subject property.
