7 Section 1134.

8 A. Upon each pickup, truck or truck-tractor owned and operated
9 by one or more farmers and used primarily for farm use, and not for
10 commercial or industrial purposes, the license fee shall be Thirty
11 Dollars (\$30.00); provided, if the farmer is also a veteran, the
12 license fee shall be Six Dollars (\$6.00). As used in this section,
13 ~~the term "pickup":~~

14 1. "Pickup" shall mean a small, light truck with an open back
15 or box used for hauling and designed primarily for the carrying of
16 property rather than people. ~~The term "truck";~~

17 2. "Truck" shall mean a motor vehicle designed or converted
18 primarily for carrying or hauling farm commodities, property,
19 livestock, or equipment, rather than people; and

20 3. "Veteran" shall mean a person who served in the uniformed
21 services and who was discharged or released therefrom under
22 conditions other than dishonorable.

23 B. The fees assessed pursuant to this section shall not apply
24 to trailers or semitrailers or combinations thereof used primarily

1 for farm use and for the transportation of products of the farm by
2 the producer thereof. Such fee shall not apply to any trailer or
3 semitrailer or combinations thereof when used primarily for the
4 transportation of any article or articles owned by the operator of
5 the trailer or semitrailer or combinations thereof and not used in
6 the furtherance of or incident to any commercial or industrial
7 enterprise. The provisions of Section 1134.2 of this title shall
8 apply to any trailers or semitrailers when used primarily for the
9 transportation of logs, ties, stave bolts and posts, direct from
10 forest to sawmill.

11 C. For the purpose of this section, a trailer or semitrailer or
12 combination thereof owned by a farmer and used primarily for the
13 purpose of transporting farm products to market or for the purpose
14 of transporting to the farm material or things to be used thereon,
15 and not for commercial or industrial purposes, may be registered for
16 One Dollar (\$1.00); provided, any such trailer used by the holder of
17 a certificate of convenience and necessity issued by the Oklahoma
18 Corporation Commission or the Interstate Commerce Commission shall
19 be conclusively presumed to be used in and for a commercial use, and
20 must be licensed as such, paying the license fees provided in
21 Section 1133 of this title.

22 D. Before a party shall be allowed to purchase a license plate
23 or claim an exception or exemption under this section, the party
24 shall:

- 1 1. Show an income tax Schedule F for the preceding year; or
- 2 2. Present a valid exemption card issued pursuant to the
- 3 provisions of Section 1358.1 of Title 68 of the Oklahoma Statutes;
- 4 and
- 5 3. If the party is a veteran, such documentation as the
- 6 Oklahoma Tax Commission deems necessary.

7 A violation shall be grounds for revocation of driver's license.
8 Any person who signs the affidavit as required by this section when
9 the person does not believe that the information in the affidavit is
10 true or knows it is not true, upon conviction, shall be guilty of
11 perjury and shall be punished as provided for by law.

12 E. Any person owning a truck upon which the farm truck license
13 fee has been paid in Oklahoma for the current year and whose truck
14 may be needed during grain harvests or other seasonal farming
15 activities for hauling farm products other than his or her own, or
16 for hauling gravel, shale or other road materials for rural roads,
17 may make application with the Oklahoma Tax Commission for a short
18 term commercial license for such truck for a period of time not to
19 exceed ninety (90) days as provided for in subsection F of this
20 section, or may make application in accordance with the Motor
21 Carrier Harvest Permit Act of 2006 if applicable.

22 F. Upon such application, the Tax Commission shall issue a
23 temporary commercial truck license and register the truck upon
24 payment of the following fees:

1 1. For thirty (30) days a fee equal to one-eighth (1/8) of the
2 annual commercial license fee required for such truck.

3 2. For sixty (60) days a fee equal to one-fourth (1/4) of the
4 annual commercial license fee required for such truck.

5 3. For ninety (90) days a fee equal to three-eighths (3/8) of
6 the annual commercial license fee required for such truck.

7 G. Provided, however, the provisions of this section shall not
8 apply to the transportation of persons or property for hire."

Plate; creating the Prisoner of War and Missing in
Action License Plate; creating the John Rex Charter
Elementary School License Plate; re-creating the
Jenks Trojans License Plate; creating the Bixby

1 Spartans License Plate; creating the Rocky Mountain
2 Elk Foundation License Plate; creating the Western
3 Heights Public Schools License Plate; creating the
4 Former Oklahoma House Member License Plate;
5 establishing plates as financial assistance license
6 plates; providing for design of license plates;
7 allowing and providing limitations on personalization
8 of license plates; requiring certain portion of fees
9 be deposited in certain funds; authorizing certain
10 licensing agreements; authorizing and limiting
11 certain payments; requiring incorporation of certain
12 numbering system; requiring creation and maintenance
13 of certain list; amending 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1127,
14 as amended by Section 1, Chapter 413, O.S.L. 2014 (47
15 O.S. Supp. 2015, Section 1127), which relates to
16 motor vehicle registration fees for armed forces
17 members; clarifying references; making terms gender
18 neutral; providing reduced cost registration for
19 Purple Heart recipients and inactive duty members of
20 the Oklahoma National Guard; creating the Prisoner of
21 War and Missing in Action License Plate Revolving
22 Fund; placing fund with the Military Department;
23 considering certain funds appropriated; exempting
24 Fund from certain budgetary requirements; requiring
certain budgetary procedures; providing for
codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.2, as
last amended by Section 12, Chapter 54, O.S.L. 2015 (47 O.S. Supp.
2015, Section 1135.2), is amended to read as follows:

Section 1135.2 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
plates to persons in recognition of their service or awards as
provided by this section.

1 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
2 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
3 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
4 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
5 registered for the current year.

6 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
7 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall
8 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.
9 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain
10 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor
11 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be
12 issued on a staggered system except for legislative plates and
13 amateur radio operator license plates.

14 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
15 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
16 applications for special license plates authorized under this
17 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
18 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
19 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
20 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
21 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
22 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
23 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
24

1 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
2 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

3 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
4 follows:

5 1. Prisoner of War License Plates - such plates shall be
6 designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United
7 States Armed Forces and civilians who were former prisoners of war
8 held by a foreign country and who can provide proper certification
9 of that status. Such persons may apply for a prisoner of war
10 license plate for no more than two vehicles with each vehicle having
11 a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving
12 spouse of any deceased former prisoner of war, if the spouse has not
13 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by
14 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a prisoner of war
15 license plate for one vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one
16 (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special
17 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to
18 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration
19 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

20 2. National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be
21 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma National
22 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide
23 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be
24 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

1 3. Air National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be
2 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma Air National
3 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide
4 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be
5 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

6 4. United States Armed Forces License Plates - such plates
7 shall be designed for active, retired, former or reserve members of
8 the United States Armed Forces, and shall identify which branch of
9 service, and carry the emblem and name of either the Army, Navy, Air
10 Force, Marines or Coast Guard, according to the branch of service to
11 which the member belongs or did belong. Former members who have
12 been dishonorably discharged shall not be eligible for such plates.
13 Persons applying for such license plate must show proof of present
14 or past military service by presenting a valid Uniformed Services
15 Identity Card or the United States Department of Defense Form ~~(DD)~~
16 214. Retired or former members who are eligible for such plates
17 shall provide proof of eligibility upon initial application, but
18 shall not be required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

19 5. Congressional Medal of Honor Recipient License Plates - such
20 plates shall be designed for any resident of this state who has been
21 awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor. Such persons may apply
22 for a Congressional Medal of Honor recipient license plate for each
23 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.
24 There shall be no registration fee for the issuance of this plate;

1 6. Missing In Action License Plates - such plates shall be
2 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who are
3 missing in action. The spouse of such missing person, if the spouse
4 has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is
5 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, and each parent of the
6 missing person may apply for a missing in action license plate upon
7 presenting proper certification that the person is missing in action
8 and that the person making the application is the qualifying spouse
9 or the parent of the missing person. The qualifying spouse and each
10 parent of the missing person may each apply for the missing in
11 action license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity
12 of one (1) ton or less;

13 7. Purple Heart Recipient License Plates - such plates shall be
14 designed for any resident of this state presenting proper
15 certification from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs
16 or the Armed Forces of the United States certifying that such
17 resident has been awarded the Purple Heart military decoration.
18 Such persons may apply for a Purple Heart recipient license plate
19 for vehicles having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
20 less. The surviving spouse of any deceased veteran who has been
21 awarded the Purple Heart military decoration, if such spouse has not
22 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage has been terminated
23 by death, divorce or annulment, may apply for such plate for one
24 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The

1 license plate created by this paragraph shall be exempt from the fee
2 provided by this section for special license plates;

3 8. Pearl Harbor Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed for any resident of this state who can be verified by the
5 United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
6 the United States as being:

7 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces on December
8 7, 1941,

9 b. stationed on December 7, 1941, during the hours of
10 7:55 a.m. to 9:45 a.m. Hawaii time at Pearl Harbor,
11 the island of Oahu, or offshore at a distance not to
12 exceed three (3) miles, and

13 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
14 States Armed Forces.

15 Such person may apply for a Pearl Harbor Survivor license plate
16 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
17 less;

18 9. Iwo Jima License Plates - such plates shall be designed for
19 any resident of this state who can be verified by the United States
20 Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United
21 States as being:

22 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces in February
23 of 1945,

24

1 b. stationed in February of 1945 on or in the immediate
2 vicinity of the island of Iwo Jima, and

3 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
4 States Armed Forces.

5 Such person may apply for an Iwo Jima license plate for each
6 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

7 Such license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK" and shall
8 contain three letters and three numbers. Between the letters and
9 numbers shall be a logo of the flag-raising at Iwo Jima. Below the
10 letters, logo and numbers, the plate shall contain the words "FEB."
11 at the left, "Iwo Jima" in the center and "1945" at the right. Such
12 plates shall not be subject to the design requirements of any other
13 license plates prescribed by law other than the space for the
14 placement of the yearly decals for each succeeding year of
15 registration after the initial issue;

16 10. D-Day Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be
17 designed for any resident of this state who can be verified by the
18 United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
19 the United States as being:

20 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces on June 6,
21 1944,

22 b. a participant in the Allied invasion of the coast of
23 Normandy on June 6, 1944; provided, if such
24 participation cannot be verified by the United States

1 Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
2 the United States, the Tax Commission may, in its
3 discretion, accept evidence of such participation from
4 the person applying for the license plate, and

5 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
6 States Armed Forces.

7 Such person may apply for a D-Day Survivor license plate for
8 each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

9 11. Killed in Action License Plates - such plates shall be
10 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were
11 killed in action. The spouse of the deceased person, if the spouse
12 has not remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by
13 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a killed in action
14 license plate upon presenting proper certification that the person
15 was killed in action and that the person making the application is
16 the qualifying spouse of the deceased person. The qualifying spouse
17 may apply for a killed in action license plate for no more than two
18 vehicles with each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1)
19 ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special
20 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to
21 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration
22 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

23 12. Gold Star Parents License Plates - such plates shall be
24 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were

1 killed during a war. The parents of the deceased person may apply
2 for a gold star license plate upon presenting proper certification
3 that the person was killed during a war and that the person making
4 the application is the parent of the deceased person. The parent
5 may apply for a gold star parent license plate for no more than two
6 vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying capacity of one
7 (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special
8 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to
9 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration
10 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

11 13. Military Decoration License Plates - such plates shall be
12 designed for any resident of this state who has been awarded the
13 Distinguished Service Medal, the Distinguished Service Cross, the
14 Distinguished Flying Cross, the Bronze Star military decoration or
15 the Silver Star military decoration. Such persons may apply for a
16 military decoration license plate for each vehicle with a rated
17 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

18 14. Vietnam Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be
19 designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United
20 States Armed Forces who served in the Vietnam Conflict. Such
21 persons may apply for a Vietnam veteran license plate for each
22 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

23 15. Police Officer License Plates - such plates shall be
24 designed for any currently employed, reserve or retired municipal

1 police officer or full-time, reserve or retired university police
2 officer certified by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and
3 Training or common education police officer certified by the Council
4 on Law Enforcement Education and Training. Police officers may
5 apply for police officer license plates for vehicles with a rated
6 capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon proof of
7 employment by or retirement from a municipal, university or common
8 education police department by either an identification card or
9 letter from the chief of the police department or the Oklahoma
10 Police Pension and Retirement Board. Retirees who are eligible for
11 such plates shall provide proof of eligibility upon initial
12 application, but shall not be required to provide proof of
13 eligibility annually. The license plates shall be designed in
14 consultation with municipal police departments of this state;
15 provided, the license plate for motorcycles may be of similar design
16 to the license plate for motor vehicles or may be a new design in
17 order to meet space requirements for a motorcycle license plate;

18 16. World War II Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be
19 designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United
20 States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be
21 verified by the Oklahoma Military Department, the Department of
22 Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as having
23 served on federal active duty anytime during the period from
24 September 16, 1940, to December 7, 1945. The former members may

1 apply for a World War II Veteran license plate for vehicles with a
2 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

3 The license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma" and shall
4 contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia
5 of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold
6 coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, U.S. Army Air Corps,
7 Marines or Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which
8 the member belonged. For the purpose of license plate
9 identification, the plate shall contain four digits, two digits at
10 the left and two digits at the right of the insignia or emblem.
11 Centered on the bottom of the license plate shall be the words
12 "WORLD WAR II";

13 17. Korean War Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be
14 designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United
15 States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be
16 verified by the Oklahoma Military Department, the Department of
17 Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as having
18 served on federal active duty anytime during the period from June
19 27, 1950, to January 31, 1955, both dates inclusive. The former
20 members may apply for a Korean War Veteran license plate for
21 vehicles with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

22 The license plate shall have the legend "OKLAHOMA" and shall
23 contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia
24 of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold

1 coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or
2 Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which the member
3 belonged. For the purpose of license plate identification, the
4 plate shall contain four digits, two digits at the left and two
5 digits at the right of the insignia or emblem. Centered on the
6 bottom of the license plate shall be the word "KOREA";

7 18. Municipal Official License Plates - such plates shall be
8 designed for persons elected to a municipal office in this state and
9 shall designate the name of the municipality and the district or
10 ward in which the municipal official serves. The plates shall only
11 be produced upon application;

12 19. Red Cross Volunteer License Plates - such plates shall be
13 designed to honor American Red Cross volunteers and staff who are
14 residents of this state. Such persons must present an
15 identification card issued by the American Red Cross and bearing a
16 photograph of the person. The license plate shall be designed with
17 the assistance of the American Red Cross and shall have the legend
18 "Oklahoma OK!" in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the legend the
19 symbol of the American Red Cross and no more than three letters and
20 three numbers shall be in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the
21 symbol and letters and numbers shall be the words "American Red
22 Cross" in black. The plates shall not be subject to the design
23 requirements of any other license plates prescribed by law other
24

1 than the space for the placement of the yearly decals for each
2 succeeding year of registration after the initial issue;

3 20. Veterans of Foreign Wars License Plates - such plates shall
4 be designed to honor the veterans of foreign wars and issued to any
5 resident of this state who is a member of a Veterans of Foreign Wars

11 and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of the
12 United States Armed Forces who served in the Persian Gulf Crisis and
13 the Desert Storm operation. Such persons may apply for a Desert
14 Storm license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity
15 of one (1) ton or less;

16 22. Military Reserve Unit License Plates - such plates shall be
17 designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of
18 a reserve unit of the United States Armed Forces. Such persons may
19 apply for a Military Reserve Unit license plate for each vehicle
20 with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

21 23. Oklahoma City Bombing Victims and Survivors License Plates
22 - such plates shall be designed and issued to any victim or survivor
23 of the bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal Building in
24 downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995;

1 24. Civil Air Patrol License Plates - such plates shall be
2 designed and issued to any person who is a member of the Civil Air
3 Patrol. Such persons may apply for a Civil Air Patrol license plate
4 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
5 less upon proof of membership in the Civil Air Patrol. The license
6 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Civil Air Patrol;

7 25. Ninety-Nines License Plates - such plates shall be designed
8 and issued to members of the Ninety-Nines. Persons applying for
9 such license plate must show proof of membership in the Ninety-
10 Nines. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with
11 the Ninety-Nines;

12 26. Combat Infantryman Badge License Plates - such plates shall
13 be designed to honor recipients of the Combat Infantryman Badge.
14 The plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK". Below the legend
15 shall be the Combat Infantryman Badge and three numbers. Below the
16 badge and the numbers shall be the words "Combat Infantryman Badge".
17 Such persons may apply for a Combat Infantryman Badge license plate
18 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
19 less;

20 27. Somalia Combat Veterans License Plates - such plates shall
21 be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member
22 of the United States Armed Forces who saw combat in the United
23 Nations relief effort. Such persons may apply for a Somalia Combat
24

1 Veteran license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
2 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

3 28. Police Chaplain License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed and issued to members of the International Conference of
5 Police Chaplains (ICPC) who have completed the ICPC requirements for
6 basic certification as a police chaplain. The license plates shall
7 be designed in consultation with the ICPC;

8 29. Joint Service Commendation Medal License Plates - such
9 plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state
10 who has been awarded the Joint Service Commendation Medal by the
11 United States Secretary of Defense;

12 30. Merchant Marine License Plates - such plates shall be
13 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
14 by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs, and issued to any
15 person who during combat was a member of the Merchant Marines as
16 certified by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs. Such
17 license plate may be issued for each vehicle with a rated carrying
18 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

19 31. Legislative License Plates - such plates shall be designed
20 for persons elected to the Oklahoma Legislature and shall designate
21 the house of the Legislature in which the legislator serves and the
22 district number;

23 32. Disabled Veterans License Plates - such plates shall be
24 designed for persons presenting proper certification from the United

1 States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the
2 United States certifying such veteran has a service-connected
3 disability rating of ~~fifty percent (50%)~~ ten percent (10%) or more,
4 regardless which agency pays the disability benefits, or that such
5 veteran has been awarded a vehicle by the United States government
6 or receives a grant from the United States Department of Veterans
7 Affairs for the purchase of an automobile due to a service-connected
8 disability rating or due to the loss of use of a limb or an eye.
9 Such persons may apply to the Tax Commission for a disabled veterans
10 license plate or to a motor license agent for a regular license
11 plate for no more than two vehicles with each vehicle having a rated
12 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving spouse of
13 any deceased disabled veteran, if the spouse has not since
14 remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by death,
15 divorce, or annulment, or a surviving spouse in receipt of
16 Dependency and Indemnity Compensation from the United States
17 Department of Veterans Affairs, may apply for a disabled veterans
18 license plate for one vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one
19 (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special
20 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to
21 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration
22 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title. The total expense of
23 this license plate shall not exceed Five Dollars (\$5.00).

1 If the person qualifies for a disabled veterans license plate
2 and is also eligible for a physically disabled placard under the
3 provisions of Section 15-112 of this title, the person shall be
4 eligible to receive a disabled veterans license plate that also
5 displays the international accessibility symbol, which is a stylized
6 human figure in a wheelchair. Upon the death of the disabled
7 veteran with a disabled veterans license plate with the
8 international accessibility symbol, the plate shall be returned to
9 the Tax Commission;

10 33. United States Air Force Association License Plates - such
11 plates shall be designed for members of the United States Air Force
12 Association. Persons applying for such license plate must show
13 proof of membership in the Association. The license plates shall be
14 designed in consultation with the Association;

15 34. Oklahoma Military Academy Alumni License Plates - such
16 plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state
17 who is an alumnus of the Oklahoma Military Academy. Such persons
18 may apply for an Oklahoma Military Academy Alumnus license plate for
19 each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.
20 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the
21 Oklahoma Military Academy and shall contain the shield of the
22 Academy;

23 35. Amateur Radio Operator License Plates - such plates shall
24 be designed and issued to any person⁷ holding a valid operator's

1 license, technician class or better, issued by the Federal
2 Communications Commission, and who is also the owner of a motor
3 vehicle currently registered in Oklahoma, in which has been
4 installed amateur mobile transmitting and receiving equipment.
5 Eligible persons shall be entitled to two special vehicle
6 identification plates as herein provided. Application for such
7 identification plates shall be on a form prescribed by the Tax
8 Commission and the plates issued to such applicant shall have
9 stamped thereon the word "Oklahoma" and bear the official call
10 letters of the radio station assigned by the Federal Communications
11 Commission to the individual amateur operator thereof. All
12 applications for such plates must be made to the Tax Commission on

7 designed for any currently employed or retired county sheriff or
8 deputy sheriff. County sheriffs or deputy sheriffs may apply for
9 such plates for vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or
10 less upon proof of employment by or retirement from a county
11 sheriff's office by either an identification card or letter from the
12 county sheriff or a government-sponsored retirement board from which
13 the county sheriff or deputy sheriff may be receiving a pension.
14 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
15 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
16 provide proof of eligibility annually. The license plates shall be
17 designed in consultation with the county sheriff offices of this

22 40. 180th Infantry License Plates - such plates shall be
23 designed for members and prior members of the 180th Infantry.

24 Persons applying for such license plate must obtain and provide

1 proof of their membership from the 180th Infantry Association. The
2 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the 180th
3 Infantry;

4 41. Operation Iraqi Freedom Veteran License Plates - such
5 plates shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or
6 present member of the United States Armed Forces who served in
7 Operation Iraqi Freedom. Such person may apply for an Operation
8 Iraqi Freedom Veteran license plate for each vehicle with a rated
9 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

10 42. United States Air Force Academy Alumni License Plates -
11 such plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this
12 state who is an alumnus of the United States Air Force Academy.
13 Such persons may apply for a United States Air Force Academy Alumnus
14 license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one
15 (1) ton or less;

16 43. Operation Enduring Freedom Veteran License ~~Plate~~ Plates -
17 such plates shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged
18 or present member of the United States Armed Forces who served in
19 Operation Enduring Freedom on or after September 11, 2001. The
20 license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Military
21 Department of the State of Oklahoma. Such person may apply for an
22 Operation Enduring Freedom Veteran license plate for each vehicle
23 with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

24

1 44. Military Multi-Decoration License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such
2 plates shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or
3 present member of the United States Armed Forces who qualifies for
4 more than one military decoration license plate pursuant to the
5 provisions of this section. The Tax Commission shall develop and
6 implement a system whereby the designs of the eligible license
7 plates can be included together on a single license plate. Such
8 person may apply for a Military Multi-Decoration license plate for
9 each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

10 45. Global War on Terror Expeditionary License ~~Plate~~ Plates -
11 such plates shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged
12 or present member of the United States Armed Forces who has earned a
13 Global War on Terror Expeditionary decoration. The license plate
14 shall be designed in consultation with the United States Institute
15 of Heraldry and the Military Department of the State of Oklahoma.
16 Such person may apply for a Global War on Terror Expeditionary
17 license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one
18 (1) ton or less;

19 46. Legion of Merit Medal Recipient License Plates - such
20 plates shall be designed for any resident of this state presenting
21 proper certification from the United States Department of Veterans
22 Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States certifying that
23 such resident has been awarded the Legion of Merit military
24 decoration. Such persons may apply for a Legion of Merit recipient

1 license plate for vehicles having a rated carrying capacity of one
2 (1) ton or less. The license plate shall be designed in
3 consultation with the Military Department of the State of Oklahoma;

4 47. 1-179th License Plates - such plates shall be designed for
5 members, prior members and members of the household of a member or
6 former member of the 1-179th Infantry. Persons applying for such
7 license plate must obtain and provide proof of their membership
8 association with the 1-179th Infantry Association. The license
9 plate shall be designed in consultation with the 1-179th Infantry;

10 48. 2-179th License Plates - such plates shall be designed for
11 members, prior members and members of the household of a member or
12 former member of the 2-179th Infantry. Persons applying for such
13 license plate must obtain and provide proof of their membership
14 association with the 2-179th Infantry Association. The license
15 plate shall be designed in consultation with the 2-179th Infantry;

16 49. Combat Action Ribbon Recipient License Plates - such plates
17 shall be designed to honor recipients of the Combat Action Ribbon
18 who present proper certification from the United States Department
19 of the Navy. The license plate shall include the Combat Action
20 Ribbon earned by the recipient. Such persons may apply for a Combat
21 Action Ribbon Recipient license plate for vehicles having a rated
22 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

23 50. Oklahoma Submarine Veterans License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such
24 plates shall be designed for any resident of this state who is a

1 United States submarine veteran and presents either a Department of
2 Defense ~~form~~ Form DD 214 or other documentation certifying such
3 service. Such persons may apply for an Oklahoma Submarine Veterans
4 license plate for vehicles having a rated capacity of one (1) ton or
5 less. The license plate design shall include both gold and silver
6 dolphins to represent both officer and enlisted service members; ~~and~~

7 51. United States Navy Seabees and Civil Engineer Corps License
8 Plate Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to any
9 honorably discharged or present member of the United States Navy
10 Seabees or Civil Engineer Corps. Such persons may apply for a
11 United States Navy Seabees and Civil Engineer Corps license plate
12 for vehicles having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
13 less. The license plate shall be designed in consultation with the
14 Military Department of the State of Oklahoma;

15 52. United States Coast Guard Auxiliary License Plates - such
16 plates shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or
17 present member of the United States Coast Guard Auxiliary. Such
18 persons may apply for a United States Coast Guard Auxiliary license
19 plate for a vehicle having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton
20 or less. The license plate shall be designed in consultation with
21 the Military Department of the State of Oklahoma;

22 53. United States Public Health Service License Plates - such
23 plates shall be designed and issued to any member of the United
24 States Public Health Service Commissioned Corps. Such persons may

1 apply for a United States Public Health Service license plate for a
2 vehicle having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.
3 The license plates shall contain the seal or logo of the United
4 States Public Health Service; and

5 54. United States Public Health Service Retired License Plates
6 - such plates shall be designed and issued to any retired member of
7 the United States Public Health Service Commissioned Corps. Such
8 persons may apply for a United States Public Health Service Retired
9 license plate for a vehicle having a rated carrying capacity of one
10 (1) ton or less. The license plate shall contain the seal or logo
11 of the United States Public Health Service.

12 C. Unless otherwise provided by this section, the fee for such
13 plates shall be Eight Dollars (\$8.00) and shall be in addition to
14 all other registration fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License
15 and Registration Act. Such fees shall be deposited in the Oklahoma
16 Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be used for the administration
17 of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act.

18 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.3, as
19 last amended by Section 1, Chapter 378, O.S.L. 2015 (47 O.S. Supp.
20 2015, Section 1135.3), is amended to read as follows:

21 Section 1135.3 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
22 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
23 plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support, interest, or
24

1 membership to or for an organization, occupation, cause or other
2 subject as provided by this section.

3 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
4 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
5 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
6 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
7 registered for the current year.

8 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
9 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall
10 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.
11 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain
12 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor
13 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be
14 issued on a staggered system.

15 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
16 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
17 applications for special license plates authorized under this
18 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
19 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
20 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
21 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
22 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
23 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
24 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for

1 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
2 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

3 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates
4 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,
5 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of
6 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special
7 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license
8 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration
9 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be
10 removed from the vehicle.

11 Except as otherwise provided in this section, for special
12 license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004, no special
13 license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax Commission
14 until the Commission receives one hundred (100) prepaid applications
15 therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by the Tax
16 Commission within one hundred eighty (180) days of the effective
17 date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall be null
18 and void. In the event one hundred (100) prepaid applications are
19 not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time
20 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

18 Fraternity membership or upon the presentment of an application for
19 a Masonic Fraternity license plate authorized and approved by the
20 Grand Lodge of Oklahoma. The license plates shall be designed in
21 consultation with the Masonic Fraternities of Oklahoma and shall
22 contain the Masonic emblem;

23 5. Shriner's Hospitals for Burned and Crippled Children License
24 Plates - such plates shall be designed to demonstrate support for

1 Shriner's Hospitals for Burned and Crippled Children and shall be
2 issued to any resident of this state who is a member of a Shriner's
3 Temple in Oklahoma. The license plate shall be designed in
4 consultation with the Shriner's Temples in Oklahoma and shall
5 contain the Shriner's emblem;

6 6. Balloonists License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such plates shall be
7 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
8 hot air ballooning in this state;

9 7. Order of the Eastern Star License Plates - such plates shall
10 be designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member
11 of an Order of the Eastern Star. Such persons may apply for an
12 Order of the Eastern Star license plate for each vehicle with a
13 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an
14 Order of the Eastern Star membership or upon the presentment of an
15 application for an Order of the Eastern Star license plate
16 authorized and approved by the organization. The license plate
17 shall be designed in consultation with the Order of the Eastern Star
18 and shall contain the Order of the Eastern Star emblem;

19 8. Knights of Columbus License Plates - such plates shall be
20 designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member of
21 the Knights of Columbus. Such persons may apply for a Knights of
22 Columbus license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
23 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of a Knights of Columbus
24 membership or upon the presentment of an application for a Knights

1 of Columbus license plate authorized and approved by the
2 organization. The license plate shall be designed in consultation
3 with the Knights of Columbus and shall contain the Knights of
4 Columbus emblem;

5 9. Jaycees License Plates - such plates shall be designed and
6 issued to members of the Jaycees. Persons applying for such license
7 plate must show proof of membership in the Jaycees. The license
8 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Jaycees;

9 10. Ducks Unlimited License Plates - such plates shall be
10 designed and issued to members of Ducks Unlimited. Persons applying
11 for and renewing such license plates must show proof of tag
12 membership in Ducks Unlimited. The license plates shall be designed
13 in consultation with Ducks Unlimited;

14 11. Kiwanis International License Plates - such plates shall be
15 designed and issued to members of Kiwanis International. Persons
16 applying for such license plate must show proof of membership in
17 Kiwanis International. The license plates shall be designed in
18 consultation with Kiwanis International;

19 12. Certified Public Accountants License Plates - such plates
20 shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a
21 Certified Public Accountant. Such persons may apply for a Certified
22 Public Accountant license plate for each vehicle with a rated
23 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of status as a
24 Certified Public Accountant. The license plates shall be designed

1 in consultation with the Oklahoma Society of Certified Public
2 Accountants;

3 13. Civil Emergency Management License Plates - such plates
4 shall be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate
5 support for the state civil emergency management system. Persons
6 applying for such license plate must show proof of official
7 affiliation by presenting a nonexpired proof of employment,
8 affiliation or retirement in the form of an identification card or
9 letter on official letterhead from a municipal, county or state
10 emergency management department head;

11 14. Civilian Conservation Corps License Plates - such plates
12 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax

17 issued to any resident of this state who is a member of a Rotarian

20 or less upon proof of a Rotarian Club membership or upon the
21 presentment of an application for a Rotarian license plate
22 authorized and approved by a Rotarian Club of Oklahoma. The license
23 plates shall be designed in consultation with the five Rotarian
24 District Governors and shall contain the Rotarian emblem;

1 16. Benevolent Protective Order of Elks License Plates - such
2 plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the

4 issued to any resident of this state who is a member of the

6 17. Humane Society License Plates - such plates shall be
7 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
8 the Humane Society of the United States. The plates shall be issued
9 to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to
10 a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate
11 shall contain the official Humane Society logo;

12 18. Oklahoma Mustang Club License Plates - such plates shall be
13 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission,
14 by the Oklahoma Mustang Club, and issued to any resident of this
15 state who is a member of the Oklahoma Mustang Club. Such persons
16 may apply for an Oklahoma Mustang Club license plate upon
17 presentment of proof of membership in the Oklahoma Mustang Club.
18 The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of

19 SECTION 3. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.5, as
20 last amended by Section 2, Chapter 378, O.S.L. 2015 (47 O.S. Supp.
21 2015, Section 1135.5), is amended to read as follows:

22 Section 1135.5 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
23 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
24

1 plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support and provide
2 financial assistance as provided by this section.

3 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
4 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
5 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
6 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
7 registered for the current year with a motor license agent.

8 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
9 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall
10 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.
11 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain
12 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor
13 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be
14 issued on a staggered system.

15 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
16 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
17 applications for special license plates authorized under this
18 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
19 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
20 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
21 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
22 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
23 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
24 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for

1 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
2 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

3 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates
4 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,
5 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of
6 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special
7 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license
8 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration
9 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be
10 removed from the vehicle.

11 For special license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004,
12 no special license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax
13 Commission until the Commission receives one hundred prepaid
14 applications therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by
15 the Tax Commission within one hundred eighty (180) days of the
16 effective date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall
17 be null and void. In the event one hundred prepaid applications are
18 not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time
19 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

20 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
21 follows:

22 1. University or College Supporter License Plates - such plates
23 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
24 support to any state-supported or private university or college. As

1 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
2 apportioned as provided in Section 1104.1 of this title;

3 2. Environmental Awareness License Plates - such plates shall
4 be designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
5 Commission by the Department of Environmental Quality in
6 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
7 person wishing to demonstrate support to implement the statewide
8 general public environmental education program created pursuant to
9 the provisions of the Oklahoma Environmental Quality Code. Such
10 plates shall be designed and issued to any person in any combination
11 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
12 personalized license plates. A dealer's license plate issued
13 pursuant to Section 1116.1 or 1128 of this title may be designated
14 an Environmental Awareness License Plate upon payment of the fee
15 imposed by this section and any other registration fees required by
16 the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. As provided in
17 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned
18 pursuant to Section 1104.2 of this title;

19 3. Firefighter License Plates - such plates shall be designed
20 for any career or retired firefighter, volunteer or paid.
21 Firefighters may apply for firefighter plates for up to four
22 vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a
23 motorcycle upon proof of a fire department membership by either an
24 identification card or letter from the chief of the fire department.

1 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
2 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
3 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any
4 deceased firefighter, if the spouse has not since remarried, may
5 apply for a firefighter license plate for one vehicle with a rated
6 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon
7 proof that the deceased firefighter was a member of a fire
8 department by either an identification card or letter from the chief
9 of the fire department. The license plate shall be designed in
10 consultation with the Oklahoma Firefighters Association.

11 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
12 shall be deposited to the Oklahoma State Firemen's Museum Building &
13 Memorial Fund for support of the Oklahoma Firefighters Museum and

15 4. Wildlife Conservation License Plates - such plates shall be
16 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
17 Commission by the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation in
18 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
19 person wishing to demonstrate support for wildlife conservation in
20 this state through the Wildlife Diversity Fund, provided for in
21 Section 3-310 of Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Such plates may
22 be designed and issued to any person as for personalized license
23 plates.

1 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
2 shall be apportioned pursuant to subsection D of Section 3-310 of
3 Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

4 5. Child Abuse Prevention License Plates - such plates shall be
5 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
6 Commission by the Office of Child Abuse Prevention in the State
7 Department of Health and the Oklahoma Committee to Prevent Child
8 Abuse, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
9 the prevention of child abuse.

10 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
11 shall be deposited in the Child Abuse Prevention Fund;

12 6. United States Olympic Committee Supporter License Plates -
13 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
14 demonstrate support for the United States Olympic Committee. The
15 plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers
16 and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized
17 license plates. The plate shall contain the official United States
18 Olympic Committee logo. The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if
19 necessary, to enter into a licensing agreement with the United
20 States Olympic Committee for any licensing fees which may be
21 required in order to use the United States Olympic Committee logo or
22 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment of not
23 more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for each license plate
24 issued;

1 7. Oklahoma History License Plates - such plates shall be
2 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate interest in
3 Oklahoma history. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
4 collected shall be deposited to the Oklahoma Historical Society
5 Revolving Fund to be used for educational purposes;

6 8. Historic Route 66 License Plates - such plates shall be
7 designed to honor historic Route 66, also known as the "Mother
8 Road". As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
9 shall be apportioned to the Oklahoma Historical Society Revolving
10 Fund to be distributed to the Route 66 Museum located in Clinton,
11 Oklahoma;

12 9. Heart of the Heartland License Plates - such plates shall be
13 designed and issued to any person wishing to honor the victims of
14 the terrorist bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal
15 Building in downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995. As provided
16 in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited
17 in the Heart of the Heartland Scholarship Fund, as established in
18 Section 2282 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

19 10. Emergency Medical Technician License Plates - such plates
20 shall be designed and issued to any person who is an emergency
21 medical technician. Such persons may apply for an emergency medical
22 technician license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying

24 technician's license. The license plate shall be designed in

1 consultation with the state association of emergency medical
2 technicians. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
3 collected shall be apportioned to the Emergency Medical ~~Technician~~
4 Personnel Death Benefit Revolving Fund created in Section 1-2505.2
5 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

6 11. Fight Breast Cancer License Plates - such plates shall be
7 designed to demonstrate support for the prevention and treatment of
8 breast cancer in this state. As provided in this section, an amount
9 of the fee collected shall be apportioned to the Breast Cancer Act
10 Revolving Fund;

11 12. Crime Victims Awareness License Plates - such plates shall
12 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
13 awareness of and support for victims of crimes. The license plates
14 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Crime Victims
15 Centre. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
16 shall be apportioned to the Attorney General's Revolving Fund for
17 the Office of the Attorney General, which is hereby directed to use
18 such funds to contract with a statewide nonprofit organization to
19 provide services to crime victims;

20 13. Oklahoma Safe Kids Association License Plates - such plates
21 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
22 support and awareness of the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association. The
23 license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma

1 the fee collected shall be deposited in the Children's Hospital -

4 14. Four-H Club License Plates - such plates shall be designed,
5 subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the
6 Four-H Foundation, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
7 support of the Four-H Club. Such plates may be designed and issued
8 to any person as for personalized license plates. As provided in
9 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned to
10 the OSU Extension Service License Plate Revolving Fund created in
11 Section 1104.4 of this title;

12 15. Agricultural Awareness License Plates - such plates shall
13 be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
14 Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and
15 Forestry in consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued
16 to any person wishing to demonstrate support of the Department's Ag
17 in the Classroom Education Program. As provided in this section, an
18 amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
19 Section 1104.3 of this title;

20 16. Oklahoma Statehood Centennial License Plates - such plates
21 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to commemorate
22 the centennial of Oklahoma's admission to statehood in 1907. The
23 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
24 Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration Commission. As

1 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
2 deposited in the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial
3 Commemoration Commission Revolving Fund created in Section 98.5 of
4 Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

5 17. Support Education License Plates - such plates shall be
6 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
7 by the State Department of Education in consultation with the
8 Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any person wishing to
9 demonstrate support for education in this state. All motor license
10 agents shall display a sample of the Support Education License plate
11 in the area of the business accessed by the public. Twenty-three
12 Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee collected shall be apportioned as

7 The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into
8 a licensing agreement with the Boy Scouts of America for any
9 licensing fees which may be required in order to use the Boy Scouts
10 of America logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide
11 for a payment to the Boy Scouts of America of not more than Twenty
12 Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

13 20. Urban Forestry and Beautification License Plates - such
14 plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the
15 Tax Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and
16 Forestry in consultation with nonprofit organizations in this state
17 that develop and operate programs to encourage urban forestry and
18 beautification, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
19 support of such programs. As provided in this section, an amount of
20 the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1104.5
21 of this title;

22 21. Oklahoma State Parks Supporter License Plates - such plates
23 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
24 Commission by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department, and

1 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma
2 state parks system. Twenty-three Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee
3 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation
4 Department Revolving Fund. Such money shall be designated for and
5 may only be expended for the support of Oklahoma state parks;

16 and shall contain the official logo of the International Association
17 of Lions Clubs. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter
18 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Lions Service
19 Foundation. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
20 the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation of not more than Ten Dollars
21 (\$10.00) for each license plate issued;

22 26. Color Oklahoma License Plates - such plates shall be
23 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
24 by the Oklahoma Native Plant Society, and issued to any person

1 wishing to demonstrate support for preserving and planting
2 wildflowers and native plants in Oklahoma and to promote Oklahoma's
3 wildflower heritage through education. As provided in this section,
4 an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in

3 59. Disabled American Veterans License Plates - such plates
4 shall be designed in consultation with the Disabled American

7 shall be authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with the
8 Disabled American Veterans Department of Oklahoma for any licensing
9 fees which may be required in order to use the organization's logo
10 or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
11 the Disabled American Veterans Department of Oklahoma of not more
12 than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued. The
13 plates shall incorporate a numbering system agreed upon by the
14 Disabled American Veterans Department of Oklahoma and the Tax
15 Commission;

16 60. Prisoner of War and Missing in Action License Plates - such
17 plates shall be issued to any person wishing to increase awareness
18 of those who are currently prisoners of war or missing in action and
19 provide financial support for current veterans. The license plates
20 shall be designed in consultation with Rolling Thunder Oklahoma. As
21 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
22 deposited in the Prisoner of War and Missing in Action License Plate
23 Revolving Fund created in Section 4 of this act;

1 61. John Rex Charter Elementary School License Plates - such
2 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
3 demonstrate support for John Rex Charter Elementary School. Such
4 plates shall be designed in consultation with the administration of
5 John Rex Charter Elementary School. The Tax Commission shall be
6 authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with John Rex Charter
7 Elementary School for any licensing fees which may be required in
8 order to use the school's logo or design. The licensing agreement

12 62. Jenks Trojans License Plates - such plates shall be
13 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for

16 The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing
17 agreement with the Jenks School District for any licensing fees
18 which may be required in order to use the school district's logo or
19 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the
20 Jenks School District of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for
21 each license plate issued;

22 63. Bixby Spartans License Plates - such plates shall be
23 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
24 the Bixby School District. The license plates shall be designed in

1 consultation with the administration of the Bixby School District.
2 The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing
3 agreement with the Bixby School District for any licensing fees
4 which may be required in order to use the school district's logo or
5 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the
6 Bixby School District of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for
7 each license plate issued;

8 64. Rocky Mountain Elk Foundation License Plates - such plates
9 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
10 support for the Rocky Mountain Elk Foundation. Such plates shall be
11 designed in consultation with the Rocky Mountain Elk Foundation.
12 The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing
13 agreement with the Rocky Mountain Elk Foundation for any licensing
14 fees which may be required in order to use the foundation's logo or
15 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the
16 Rocky Mountain Elk Foundation of not more than Twenty Dollars
17 (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

18 65. Western Heights Public Schools License Plates - such plates
19 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
20 support for the Western Heights School District. The license plates
21 shall be designed in consultation with the administration of the
22 Western Heights School District. The Tax Commission shall be
23 authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with the Western
24 Heights School District for any licensing fees which may be required

1 in order to use the school district's logo or design. The licensing
2 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Western Heights School
3 District of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
4 plate issued; and

5 66. Former Oklahoma House Member License Plates - such plates
6 shall be designed and issued to any person who previously served as
7 a member of the Oklahoma House of Representatives. The license
8 plates shall be designed in consultation with Friends of the
9 Oklahoma House of Representatives, Inc. The Tax Commission shall be
10 authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with Friends of the
11 Oklahoma House of Representatives, Inc. for any licensing fees which
12 may be required in order to use the logo or design of Friends of the
13 Oklahoma House of Representatives, Inc. The licensing agreement
14 shall provide for a payment to Friends of the Oklahoma House of
15 Representatives, Inc. of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for
16 each license plate issued. The Tax Commission shall create and
17 maintain a list of former members of the Oklahoma House of
18 Representatives eligible to be issued such plates. The Tax
19 Commission shall confer as needed with the Chief Clerk of the
20 Oklahoma House of Representatives to confirm that such list is
21 complete and accurate.

22 C. The fee for such plates shall be Thirty-five Dollars
23 (\$35.00) and shall be in addition to all other registration fees

8 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be used for the

11 3. Any remaining amounts of the fee shall be apportioned as
12 provided in Section 1104 of this title.

13 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1104.29 of Title 47, unless
15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee authorized by Section
17 1135.5 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes for the Prisoner of War
18 and Missing in Action License Plates shall be deposited in the
19 Prisoner of War and Missing in Action License Plate Revolving Fund
20 created in subsection B of this section.

21 B. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving
22 fund for the Oklahoma Military Department to be designated the
23 "Prisoner of War and Missing in Action License Plate Revolving
24 Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal

1 year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received by the
2 Department pursuant to the provisions of subsection A of this
3 section. All monies accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby
4 appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Department for
5 the purpose of providing grants to the Oklahoma Chapter of Honor
6 Flights for the purpose of transporting Oklahoma veterans to
7 Washington, D.C., to visit those memorials dedicated to honor their
8 service and sacrifices. Expenditures from the fund shall be made
9 upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as
10 prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and
11 Enterprise Services for approval and payment.

12 C. The Oklahoma Legislature hereby declares that the Oklahoma
13 Chapter of Honor Flights provides an important service to the
14 inhabitants of this state as a community and further finds that the
15 services performed by the Oklahoma Chapter of Honor Flights are
16 adequate consideration for the funds received pursuant to this
17 section.

18 SECTION 5. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1127, as
19 amended by Section 1, Chapter 413, O.S.L. 2014 (47 O.S. Supp. 2015,
20 Section 1127) is amended to read as follows:

21 Section 1127. A. 1. All vehicles owned by:
22 a. members of the Armed Forces of the United States
23 assigned to duty in this state in compliance with
24 official military or naval orders, or their spouses,

1 b. members of the Reserve Corps of the Armed Forces of
2 the United States assigned to duty in this state in
3 compliance with official military or naval orders, or
4 their spouses, and

5 c. members of the Oklahoma National Guard or their
6 spouses ~~assigned to duty in this state in compliance~~
7 ~~with official military or naval orders,~~

8 d. Purple Heart recipients as certified by the United
9 States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed
10 Forces of the United States, who reside in Oklahoma,
11 or their spouses, or owned by

12 e. the spouse, who resides in Oklahoma, of a member of
13 the Armed Forces of the United States serving in a
14 foreign country,

15 which ~~vehicles~~ are not being used in a trade or business or for any
16 commercial purpose, are hereby classified specially for vehicle
17 license and registration purposes in this state.

18 2. Any such vehicle described in paragraph 1 of this
19 subsection, which is not registered and licensed for the current
20 year in the state of residence or domicile of the ~~serviceman,~~
21 ~~Guardman, or~~ service member, Reservist, member of the Guard or of
22 the spouse owning the vehicle must be registered for the current
23 year in Oklahoma as herein provided, except that any such vehicle
24 which has been licensed in some other state by such ~~serviceman,~~

1 ~~Guard~~man, service member, Reservist, member of the Guard or spouse
2 while the ~~serviceman, Guardsman, or~~ service member, Reservist or
3 member of the Guard was stationed in the other state may be operated
4 in this state for the remainder of the year or period for which it
5 is licensed. If such vehicle currently is registered with the Armed
6 Forces of the United States rather than being registered in a state
7 and the ~~serviceman, Guardsman, or~~ service member, Reservist or
8 member of the Guard is transferred to a duty station within this
9 state pursuant to military orders, the ~~serviceman, Guardsman,~~
10 service member, Reservist, member of the Guard or spouse owning the
11 vehicle shall not be required to register the vehicle in this state
12 for a period of thirty (30) days after the date the ~~serviceman,~~
13 ~~Guard~~man, or service member, Reservist or member of the Guard is
14 required to report for duty pursuant to the military.

15 3. The ~~serviceman, Guardsman,~~ service member, Reservist, member
16 of the Guard, Purple Heart recipient or spouse applying for the
17 registration of any such vehicle described in paragraph 1 of this
18 subsection shall submit an appropriate statement, to be attached to
19 the vehicle registration application, showing the following: A
20 description of the vehicle owned by applicant; the state and address
21 of the applicant's legal residence or domicile; that applicant or
22 applicant's spouse ~~is on active duty in the Armed Forces of the~~
23 ~~United States assigned or stationed at a named location in~~
24 ~~compliance with official military orders~~ meets the eligibility

1 requirements established in paragraph 1 of this subsection. The
2 statement shall be signed by the applicant and certified to by a
3 proper officer of the organization to which the applicant is
4 assigned for duty or where the applicant is a member of the Guard,
5 Purple Heart recipient or the spouse of ~~such serviceman, Guardsman,~~
6 ~~or~~ a service member, Reservist or member of the Guard serving in a
7 foreign country, the statement shall be signed by the member of the
8 Guard, Purple Heart recipient or spouse under the penalties of
9 perjury. The application shall be accompanied by a registration fee
10 of Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00).

11 B. Any Oklahoma resident who is stationed out of state due to
12 an official assignment of the Armed Forces of the United States or
13 their spouse shall be entitled to register his or her vehicle or
14 vehicles in this state for the same registration fee afforded
15 members of the Armed Forces of the United States assigned to duty in
16 this state pursuant to subsection A of this section. Such Oklahoma
17 resident or their spouse who is stationed out of state due to an
18 official assignment of the Armed Forces of the United States shall
19 be exempt from the vehicle inspection requirements of Section 1105
20 of this title; provided, such Oklahoma resident or his or her spouse
21 who is stationed out of state presents valid documentation
22 acceptable to the Oklahoma Tax Commission evidencing that such
23 inspection has been made by an out-of-state authority acceptable to
24 the Tax Commission.

1 Any Oklahoma resident who is stationed out of state due to an
2 official assignment of the Armed Forces of the United States may
3 authorize his or her parents to register his or her vehicle or
4 vehicles as provided for in this subsection if the ~~serviceman,~~
5 ~~Guardman,~~ or service member, Reservist or member of the Guard is
6 not able to register the vehicle at the appropriate time.

7 C. Any Oklahoma resident who is a member of the Armed Forces of
8 the United States, Reserve Corps of the Armed Forces of the United
9 States or the Oklahoma National Guard stationed outside of the state
10 due to official assignment of the Armed Forces of the United States,
11 or his or her spouse, shall be exempt from the penalties assessed
12 pursuant to paragraph 4 of subsection C of Section 1115, subsection
13 F of Section 1132 and subsection C of Section 1151 of this title for
14 the duration of such official assignment and for a period of sixty
15 (60) days after such assignment ends. If registration is not
16 completed after the sixtieth day, the expiration date and the period
17 for assessment of penalties shall commence on the sixty-first day.
18 The exemption provided for in this section shall be granted only if
19 the ~~serviceman,~~ ~~Guardman,~~ service member, Reservist, member of the
20 Guard or spouse registering such vehicle submits an appropriate
21 statement, to be attached to the vehicle registration application,
22 showing the following: A description of the vehicle owned by
23 applicant; the state and address of the applicant's legal residence
24 or domicile; that the applicant or applicant's spouse is on active

1 duty in the Armed Forces of the United States assigned or stationed
2 at a named location outside the state in compliance with official
3 military orders. The statement shall be signed by the applicant and
4 certified to by a proper officer of the organization to which the
5 applicant is assigned for duty or where the applicant is the spouse
6 of such ~~serviceman, Guardsman, or~~ service member, Reservist or
7 member of the Guard serving outside the state, the statement shall
8 be signed by his or her spouse under the penalties of perjury.

9 D. ~~The~~ Unless provided otherwise in this section, the reduced
10 registration fee provided herein shall not apply to vehicles owned
11 by retired members of the Armed Forces, inactive members of the
12 Reserve Corps of the Armed Forces, ~~inactive members of the Oklahoma~~
13 ~~National Guard~~ and other members and former members of the Armed
14 Forces of the United States who are not on active duty.

15 SECTION 6. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.
