8	21 O.S. 2011, Section 1835, which relates to trespass without permission; modifying language; modifying definition; describing method for posting with purple
9	paint marks; specifying requirements for posting; construing provision; updating language; and
10	providing an effective date.
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13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2011, Section 1835, is
15	amended to read as follows:
16	Section 1835. A. Whoever shall willfully or maliciously enter
17	the garden, yard, pasture or field of another after being expressly
18	forbidden to do so or without permission by the owner or lawful
19	occupant thereof when such property is posted, as defined by this
20	subsection, shall be deemed guilty of trespass and upon conviction
21	thereof shall be fined in any sum not to exceed punished by a fine
22	of not more than Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00); provided, that
23	this provision shall not apply to registered land surveyors and
24	registered professional engineers for the purpose of land surveying

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1 in the performance of their professional services; and, provided 2 further, that anyone who willfully or maliciously enters any such garden, yard, pasture or field, and therein commits or attempts to 3 4 commit waste, theft, or damage shall be deemed quilty of a 5 misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum 6 punished by a fine of not less than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) nor more 7 than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), or by confinement imprisonment in the county jail for not less than thirty (30) days nor more than 8 9 six (6) months, or both such fine and imprisonment. For purposes of 10 this section subsection, "posted" means exhibiting:

11 <u>1. Exhibiting</u> signs to read as follows: "PROPERTY RESTRICTED"; 12 "POSTED - KEEP OUT"; "KEEP OUT"; "NO TRESPASSING"; or similar signs 13 which are displayed. Property that is fenced or not fenced must 14 have such signs placed conspicuously and at all places where entry 15 to the property is normally expected; or

16 <u>2. Placing identifying purple paint marks on posts around the</u> 17 property. Each purple paint mark shall be a vertical line of at 18 <u>least eight (8) inches in length and the bottom of the mark shall be</u> 19 <u>no less than three (3) feet and no more than five (5) feet high.</u> 20 <u>The purple paint marks shall be placed no more than one hundred</u> 21 <u>(100) feet apart and at each point of entry and shall be readily</u> 22 <u>visible to any person approaching the property</u>.

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B. No provisions of this act section shall be construed to
conflict with Section 5-202 or 6-304 of Title 29 of the Oklahoma
Statutes.

Whoever shall willfully enter the pecan grove of another 5 without the prior consent of the owner or occupant thereof to so do shall be deemed guilty of trespass and upon conviction thereof shall 6 7 be fined in any sum not to exceed punished by a fine of not more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00); provided, that anyone who 8 9 willfully enters any such pecan grove and therein commits or 10 attempts to commit waste, theft, or damage shall be deemed guilty of 11 a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum 12 punished by a fine of not more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), 13 or by confinement imprisonment in the county jail for not less than 14 thirty (30) days nor more than six (6) months, or by both such fine 15 and imprisonment.

16 Whoever shall willfully or maliciously enter upon property D. 17 owned or managed by the Grand River Dam Authority without permission 18 when such property is posted shall be deemed guilty of misdemeanor 19 trespass and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not 20 to exceed punished by a fine of not more than Two Hundred Fifty 21 Dollars (\$250.00); provided, that this provision shall not apply to 22 registered land surveyors and registered professional engineers for 23 the purpose of land surveying in the performance of their 24 professional services; and, provided further, that anyone who

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1 willfully or maliciously enters upon property owned or managed by 2 the Grand River Dam Authority without permission and therein commits or attempts to commit waste, theft, or damage shall be deemed quilty 3 4 of misdemeanor trespass, and upon conviction thereof shall be fined 5 in any sum punished by a fine of not less than Fifty Dollars 6 (\$50.00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), or by 7 confinement imprisonment in the county jail for not less than thirty 8 (30) days nor more than six (6) months, or both such fine and 9 imprisonment. For purposes of this section subsection, "posted" 10 means exhibiting signs to read as follows: "PROPERTY RESTRICTED"; 11 "POSTED - KEEP OUT"; "KEEP OUT"; "NO TRESPASSING"; or similar signs which are displayed. Property that is fenced or not fenced must 12 13 have such signs placed conspicuously and at all places where entry 14 to the property is normally expected.

15 Notwithstanding the provisions of this section, the Ε. 16 Governor's Mansion and its grounds and appurtenances shall not be 17 required to be posted with signs warning against trespass. Any 18 person who shall willfully or maliciously enter the grounds of the 19 Governor's Mansion within the State Capitol Park, as defined in 20 Section 1811.4 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes, except at a 21 place where entry to the property is normally expected shall be 22 deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be fined in 23 a sum punished by a fine of not more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), or by confinement imprisonment in the county jail for not 24

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1	less than thirty (30) days nor more than six (6) months, or by both
2	fine and imprisonment.
3	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
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
